PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor JOHN DAVIES ORMOND, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in the Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the "District Highways Act, 1856," Session 3, No. 4, of the Province of Wellington, and now in force in the Province of Hawke's Bay, it is provided that the Superintendent may, for the purposes of the Act, from time to time, by proclamation, divide the province, or any part thereof, into districts. And whereas it is expedient to bring certain districts in the Province of Hawke's Bay under the operations of the said Act.

Now, therefore, I, JOHN DAVIES ORMOND, Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in virtue of the powers vested in me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that that portion of the province situate within the limits hereinafter specified, shall form and constitute a District for the purpose of the "District Highways Act, 1856," viz.:—

South Ruataniwha District, No. 1.

Bounded towards the north by the Waipawa river; on the east by the Public road from Waipawa to Waipukurau; on the south by the Tuki Tuki river; and on the west by the boundary of the Province.
