PROCLAMATION.

By JOHN DAVIES ORMOND, Superintendent of the Province of
Hawke's Bay, in the Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Provincial Council of Hawke's Bay, intituled "The Hawke's Bay Sheep Act, 1871," it is provided that the Superintendent may from time to time, by Proclamation in the *Hawke's Bay Gazette*, appoint an Inspector or Inspectors of Sheep for the purposes of this Act as he may think fit, and may at any time annul such appointments and make others, and may proclaim a principal office in Napier for such Inspector or Inspectors.

Inspectors of Sheep for the said Province of Hawke's Bay; and do also proclaim that the room at present occupied by Mr. G. Peacock, in the Government Buildings, Napier, shall be the principal office at Napier of the Inspectors of Sheep for Hawke's Bay.
