WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly, intituled "The Fire Inspectors Act, 1870," it is enacted that the Superintendent of any Province may from time to time appoint for any town within the Province, of which he is Superintendent, one or more persons to such town, as he shall from time to time think fit, to be called a Fire Inspector.

Now, therefore, I, JOHN DAVIES ORMOND, Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, do hereby appoint

a Fire Inspector for the Town of Napier, in the said Province of Hawke's Bay.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Provincial Council of the Province of Hawke's Bay, Session 12, No. 1, it is amongst other things enacted that the Superintendent may, from time to time, by proclamation, appoint Pounds and Poundkeepers, at such places as he may think fit, and at any time to annul such appointments and make others.

Now, therefore, I, JOHN DAVIES ORMOND, Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, do hereby annul the appointment of John Nicholson as Poundkeeper for Waipukurau, and do hereby proclaim that the Stockyard, erected at Waipukurau Accommodation House, shall be a Public Pound, and I do hereby appoint

Poundkeeper of the said Pound.
