## PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor JOHN DAVIES ORMOND, Esq., Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in the Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the "Highways Act, 1871," passed by the Provincial Council of Hawke's Bay, it is provided that the Superintendent may, for the purposes of the Act, from time to time, by proclamation, divide the Province or any part thereof into districts, and in like manner to alter and amend the names or boundaries of, or abolish any districts, and to create new districts; and that it is expedient to alter and amend the districts formerly known as Waipukurau District and West Waipawa District, and to create Districts in lieu thereof, which shall thereafter be known as the Waipukurau District and the West Waipawa District.

Now, therefore, I, JOHN DAVIES ORMOND, Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in virtue of the powers vested in me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the Proclamation, dated the 5th day of October, 1872, shall, so far as regards the District therein created, called the Waipukurau District, be rescinded, as from the date

hereof; also that the Proclamation, dated the 15th day of April, 1872, shall, so far as regards the District therein created, called the West Waipawa District, be rescinded, as from the date hereof. And I do further declare and proclaim that every of the several areas of land described in the Schedule to this Proclamation as the boundaries hereof, and severally laid down in each Schedule, shall form a separate Highway District, under the respective names of Waipukurau District and West Waipawa District, within the terms and meaning of the said "Highways Act, 1871."

## SCHEDULES.

### *Waipukurau Road Board District.*

Starts at the junction of the Mangataratara stream with the Tuki Tuki river; follows up the Mangataratara to its junction with the Tangitupura, and up that stream to the boundary line of the

Hapuku Block : thence along that line, in a Westerly direction, to the Maharakeke stream; down that stream to its junction with the Makaretu river; down that river to its junction with the Tuki Tuki river, and down that river to the Main South Road; following along that road to the Waipawa river, and down that river to its junction with the Tuki Tuki; crossing that river and following down its Southern bank to its junction with the Mangataratara stream at the starting point.

*Waipawa West Road Board District.*

Starts from the Te Aute road at the South boundary of Block 49, Patangata District; follows along the South boundary of Blocks 49, 23, 18 and 179, to the South-West corner of Block 179; thence along the West boundary of Blocks 179 and 144 to the North-East corner of Block 4, and thence along the North boundary of that Block to the

Mangaonuku river, and down that river to its junction with the Waipawa, and down that river to the Eastern boundary of the Township of Abbotsford (Waipawa), being the Western boundary of Block 45; along that boundary and the Northern boundary of the said Township of Abbotsford, being part of Block 46, to the Western side of the Te Aute road, and along that road to the starting point.
