PROCLAMATION.

By JOHN DAVIES ORMOND, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in the Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the "Highways Act, 1871," passed by the Provincial Council of Hawke's Bay, it is provided if the ratepayers of any district shall at the first or any annual meeting fail, neglect, or refuse to elect a Board, and the Chairman of such first or annual meeting respectively shall not

within one month after the date thereof have communicated to the Superintendent a reason which to the Superintendent shall appear sufficient for such failure, neglect, or refusal, then the Superintendent shall appoint five persons qualified as in the Act provided, to be the District Board for the ensuing year, and the persons so appointed shall be empowered to act in all respects as if they had been elected at such first or annual meeting respectively. And whereas the ratepayers of the North Ruataniwha District have neglected to comply with the provisions of the Act.

Now, therefore I, John Davies Ormond, Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in virtue of the powers vested in me in this behalf, do hereby appoint the following five ratepayers to be a District Board for the ensuing year for the North Ruataniwha District, viz. :-

Messrs. G. G. Carlyon, M. Stokes, J. Mathews, J. Holden, and H. McLean.
