PROCLAMATION.

By JOHN DAVIES ORMOND, Esq., Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, in the Island of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Provincial Council of the Province of Hawke's Bay, Session 12, No 1, it is amongst other things enacted that the Superintendent may from time to time by proclamation, appoint Pounds and Poundkeepers at such places as he may think fit, and at any time annul such appointment and make others.
