**H**IS Worship the Mayor begs to give notice that at a meeting of the Municipal Council, to be held on the 2nd March, 1876, he will move—

“That the sum of Ten Thousand Pounds (£10,000) be borrowed, in accordance with “The Napier Municipal Council Empowering and Waterworks Loan Act, 1875,” for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the scheme for supplying portions of the Borough of Napier with water, approved of by the Council and that the said sum be borrowed by the Corporation on the security of the rate struck on the 3rd February, 1876; and that the Corporation issue debentures in sums of £100 each with Coupons attached, such debentures to be for a period of fourteen years, bearing interest at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, payable half-yearly; the principal and interest to be payable in cash in London.”
