PROCLAMATION

By His Honour WILLIAM DOUGLAS HALL BAILLIE, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, in the Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS, by an Act passed by the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Marlborough, in Session III., No. 1, intituled, "The Education Act, 1861," and assented to by His Excellency the Governor, it is amongst other things enacted, that for the purposes of that Act it should be lawful for the Superintendent to constitute within the Province Educational Districts, and to make such provisions for carrying this Act into operation as he shall think expedient until the Election of the Education Board. Now, therefore, I, the Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, do hereby proclaim and constitute the following Districts for the purposes of the said in part recited Act, that is to say:—

PICTON DISTRICT,

Circle of four miles radius, measured from the Government Offices, Picton.

BLLENHEIM DISTRICT,

Bounded on the West by public road

between sections numbered 61 and 62, Omaka; on the North by the Opawa river from the western boundary to the public road between sections numbered 65 and 39, Wairau West, and thence by said public road to the Wairau river; on the North-east by the Wairau river; on the East and South by the circumference of a circle of four miles radius, measured from the School-house, Blenheim.

RENWICK DISTRICT,

Bounded on the North by the Wairau and Opawa rivers; on the East by public road between sections numbered 61 and 62, Omaka; on the South and West by the circumference of a circle of four miles radius, measured from the centre of the School Reserve, Renwick.

WAIRAU VALLEY DISTRICT,

Bounded on the North by the Wairau river; and on the East, South, and West, by the circumference of a circle of four miles radius, measured from the centre of the Educational Reserve on section numbered 14, Wairau Valley.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand,

intituled "The Provincial Reserved Bills Act, 1858," it is provided, whenever any Bill shall have passed the Provincial Council of any Province, and shall have been reserved by the Superintendent for the signification of the Governor's pleasure thereon, such Bill shall not have any force or authority within the said Province until the Superintendent shall signify, either by speech or message, to the Provincial Council, or by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette* of the said Province, that such Bill has been laid before the Governor, and that the Governor has assented to the same :

And, whereas an Act, intituled the "Dog Nuisance Abatement Act," was passed by the Provincial Council of Marlborough, on the 3rd day of October, 1861, but was reserved for the signification of the Governor's pleasure thereon.

Now, therefore, I, WILLIAM DOUGLAS HALL BAILLIE, do hereby proclaim and notify that the above mentioned Act, having been duly laid before His Excellency the Governor, and the Governor having assented to the same, is, under the provisions of the said recited Act of the General Assembly, in full force and authority within the Province of Marlborough from the date of this Proclamation.
