PROCLAMATION.

By His Honour WILLIAM DOUGLAS HALL BAILLIE, Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, in the Colony of New Zealand, &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled "The Provincial Elections Act, 1858," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor of the Colony to delegate to the Superintendent of any Province the power of appointing and removing Returning Officers, and also of appointing and establishing Polling Places for the Election of Superintendent or of Members of the Provincial Council of such province:

And whereas His Excellency Colonel Thomas Gore Browne, C.B., Governor of the said Colony, by warrant under his hand, bearing date the first day of October, 1861, did delegate to me, the said William Douglas Hall Baillie, as Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, the above recited powers.

And whereas, Mr. W. COLLIE has resigned the appointment of Returning Officer for the Districts of Blenheim and Lower Wairau.

Now, therefore, I, the said William Douglas Hall Baillie, Superintendent of the said province, in pursuance of the

power and authority in me vested, do hereby appoint

to be Returning Officer for the Electoral Districts of Blenheim and Lower Wairau, in the said Province.
