**PROCLAMATION.**

By His Honour THOMAS CARTER, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, in the Islands of New Zealand.

**I,** THE SUPERINTENDENT of the Province of Marlborough, do hereby proclaim that at noon on SATURDAY, Twenty-ninth day of August next, the Commissioner of Crown Lands for this Province will, at the Crown Land Office, Picton, in this Province, put up to Auction and offer to Public Competition, under the provisions of the Land Regulations now in force within this Province, the Allotments of Town Land, Rural Land, and Pasture Land, that are specified in the Schedules hereunto annexed, at the upset prices mentioned therein.
