PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance of the provisions of clause 10 of the "New Provinces Act, 1858," and in virtue of a notification under the hand of His Excellency the Governor, dated the sixteenth day of August, 1864, notifying that the office of Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough is now vacant, and that His Excellency had accepted the resignation by Thomas Carter, Esquire, of the office of Superintendent of the said Province on the thirtieth day of July last, and received by

me this twenty-third day of August, 1864, I, William Douglas Hall Baillie, do hereby convene the members of the Provincial Council of Marlborough to meet at the Council Chamber, Picton, at four o'clock, p.m., on Monday, the fifth day of September, 1864, for the purpose of electing a Superintendent in the place of the said Thomas Carter.
