ZEALAND.

MIDDLE DISTRICT.

In the matter of The Debtor and Creditor Act,  
1862; and

In the matter of the Petition of Arthur Devery  
and Luke Green.

On the Twenty-fourth day of February, one  
thousand eight hundred and sixty-five.

**O**N reading the petition of the said  
Arthur Devery and Luke Green, filed  
herein, and the schedule thereunto annexed; and  
on reading the affidavit of Arthur Devery, also  
filed herein; and on hearing Mr. Izard as coun-  
sel for the petitioners; it is ordered that the  
estate and effects of the said petitioners be  
forthwith sequestered on the hands of John  
Sharp, Esquire, the Registrar of this Honourable  
Court, at Nelson, and that the said petitioners do  
personally appear for hearing, to be examined  
touching the matter mentioned or referred to in

their said petition before this Honourable Court,  
at Nelson, on such day in the month of May  
next, and at such time and place as the said  
John Sharp shall appoint: and that the said  
Luke Green be forthwith discharged from cus-  
tody at the suit of Nicholas Maloney, or of any  
other person or persons whatever: and that the  
persons and estates of the said Arthur Devery  
and Luke Green shall, until such hearing afore-  
said, be protected from arrest, execution, or other  
legal process, such protection, however, to cease  
and be of no effect, should any creditor of the  
said petitioners, or either of them, be in a posi-  
tion to issue a writ of arrest against either of  
them in accordance with the regulations of the  
Writ of Arrest Act, to the satisfaction of a  
Judge of the said Court, or a Registrar of the  
said Court in the absence of a Judge thereof:  
provided, however, that such cesser of protection  
shall, in the event aforesaid, extend only to affect  
such one of the two said petitioners as shall have  
rendered himself liable to arrest as aforesaid.

## TO STOP UP,

Part of a road in the Kaituna District, being the road laid down on the plan leading from the Wairau River through the Waikakaho Valley, and which is shown by green color on the plan attached to this application, and is more particularly described as follows:—

The portion of the road commencing from a public road at the S.E. corner of section 115, and crossing sections numbered respectively 115, 116, 117, 118, 119, and terminating at the western boundary of section 118.

## AND TO SUBSTITUTE

And make in the place thereof, certain other portions of a road 100 links in width, and which is shown by pink color on the plan attached to this application, and is more particularly described as follows:—

The portion of road commencing from a public road at the S.E. corner of section 115, thence following the base of the hills crossing over section 115 till it meets a public road, thence along the said public road to the base of the hills, thence following the foot of the hills to the termination of section 118.
