PROCLAMATION.

By his Honor WILLIAM HENRY EYES,
Esquire, Superintendent of the
Province of Marlborough, in the

WHEREAS certain portions of the lands of the Crown within the Province of Marlborough have been from time to time set aside for various public purposes, under the provisions of the regulations for the sale and disposal of the Waste Lands of the Crown within the said Province: And whereas such lands have never been granted to the Superintendent of the said Province; and whereas it is expedient that such lands so set aside should be exempted from such reservation, and dealt with for the purposes of sale, or otherwise, in accordance with the provisions of the aforesaid regulations:

Now, therefore, I, WILLIAM HENRY EYES, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, do hereby proclaim and notify that the pieces or parcels of land set forth in the Schedule hereunto annexed shall be deemed to be, and the same shall be from the date hereof Waste Lands of the Crown, and shall be dealt with in accordance with the provisions of the Land Regulations in force within the said Province.

Given under my hand, and issued under the Public Seal of the Province, at Blenheim, this twenty-third day of February, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty-six.

HIS Honor the Superintendent directs it to be notified that the undermentioned portions of the Waste Lands of the Crown have been reserved for public purposes:—

A Block of Land at the Amuri Boat Harbour, containing twenty acres * more or less, for a Landing place.

A Block of Land in the District of Wakefield Downs, being part of Section numbered 49, bounded towards the North by a stream known as Nina Creek, running into the Awatere River; towards the North-East by a public road; towards the South-East by a part of the said section, being Crown Land; towards the South-West 2,000 links by a part of the said section granted to the Trustees of the Presbyterian Church; and towards the North-West, 900 links, by a public road, until it intersects the aforesaid stream; containing sixteen acres and three roods, more or less, as a public Cemetery.
