PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor WILLIAM HENRY EYES,
Esquire, Superintendent of the
Province of Marlborough, in the
Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by Proclamation under my hand, bearing date the Eighteenth day of March, 1867, the Provincial Council of the Province of Marlborough was summoned to meet in the Council Chamber, Blenheim, on Tuesday, the Sixteenth day of April, 1867; and whereas it has been deemed expedient to extend the time of meeting of the said Council.

Now therefore, I, WILLIAM HENRY EYES, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, in pursuance of the power and authority vested in me in this behalf, do hereby prorogue the Provincial Council of Marlborough until WEDNESDAY, the First day of May, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven.

And I do further announce and proclaim that the Provincial Council of the Province of Marlborough shall meet for the despatch of business on the said First day of May, at Four o'clock in the afternoon, at the Council Chamber, Blenheim, and the members of the said Council are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

Given under my hand, and issued under the public seal of the Province, at the Superintendent's Office, Blenheim, this First day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor WILLIAM HENRY EYES,
Esquire, Superintendent of the
Province of Marlborough, in the
Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intitled "The Marine Act, 1866," it shall be lawful for the Superintendent of any Province, from time to time, as occasion may require, by Proclamation for that purpose, published in the *Gazette* of the Province, to define the limits and boundaries for the purposes of this Act, of any Wharf, Quay, Pier, or Dock, within such Province, and such Proclamation, from time to time, to revoke, and in manner aforesaid to re-define such limits and boundaries.

Now therefore, I, WILLIAM HENRY EYES, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, in pursuance of the powers vested in me, do hereby revoke the Proclamation issued by me under the said Act, and bearing date the nineteenth day of March, 1867, and do hereby proclaim and declare that the limits and boundaries of the Quays and Wharfs of the Towns of Blenheim and Picton, in the said Province respectively, shall be as follows, that is to say:—

The Blenheim Quays and Wharfs shall be bounded toward the North by a line commencing at and from the North-Eastern angle of Section 41, Town of Blenheim, to the North-Western angle of Section 46;

thence towards the East by Sections 46 and 47; thence towards the North by Section 47, the abuttal of Sinclair-street, Section 48, and Redwood-street; thence towards the East by the Eastern-side of Redwood-street, to a point at right angles with the North-Eastern corner of Section 1; thence by the Northern boundary of Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4, and a line from Section 4, to the North-Eastern corner of Section 25; thence by a line to the nearest angle of Section 26; thence by Section 26, the abuttal of High-street, Section 36, and a line from the Northern extremity of that Section to Section 41; thence by Section 41, to the starting point, and shall also include the right bank of the Opawa river, commencing at a point six hundred yards below the Police station, and extending for a distance of one hundred yards, measured down the stream, along the bank.

The Picton Quay, and wharf shall comprise the Government Reserve marked D on the plan of the Town of Picton, in the Crown Lands Office of this Province.

Given under my hand, and issued under the Public Seal of the Province of Marlborough, at Blenheim, this Fifth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven.
