*Declaring Certain Depasturing Licenses  
Forfeited.*

**W**HEREAS, the Rents due under Depasturing License dated the Tenth day of October, 1861, made out in the name of Robert Blaymires for the Run in the District of Pelorus Sound, estimated to contain Nine thousand, seven hundred acres, within the following boundaries:—  
“On the North-east by Surveyed land, Freehold land, and Endeavor Inlet, Queen Charlotte Sound; on the Eastward by land purchased by P. Dryden, and by Dryden and Miritu Bays, Queen Charlotte Sound; on the South-east by Native Reserves; on the Southward by Native Reserves, Government Reserves and Tahuahua, Queen Charlotte Sound; on the South-west and West by Coniston Water, and by a line drawn from the Northern point of the surveyed Sections Endeavour Inlet, to Section No. 10, Ohuaparuparu, Coniston Water.—
