Between Arthur Beauchamp, James McBeth,
and William Weiford, Plaintiffs; and
Godwin George Hood, Defendant,

WHEREAS by a writ of *Fieri Facias*
issued in this action, and directed
to me, I am commanded of the real and
personal estate of the above named defend-
ant to be caused to be made the sum of
ninety-two pounds ten shillings and six
pence, together with interest upon the said
sum at the rate of eight pounds for every
hundred pounds by the year, from the first
