PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor WILLIAM HENRY EYES,
Esquire, Superintendent of the
Province of Marlborough, in the
Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General
Assembly of New Zealand, inti-
tuled "The Provincial Reserved Bills Act,
1858," it is provided that, whenever any bill
shall have passed the Provincial Council of
any Province, and shall have been reserved
for the signification of the Governor's plea-
sure thereon, such Bill shall not have any
force or authority within the said Province
until the Superintendent shall signify,
either by speech or message to the Provin-
cial Council, or by proclamation in the
Government Gazette of the said Province,
that such Bill has been laid before the
Governor, and that the Governor has as-
sented to the same:

And whereas the following Acts, entitled
"The Appropriation Act, 1869;"
"Dog Nuisance Abatement Act Amend-
ment Act, 1869;"
"The Board of Works for the Town
of Picton Trust Act, 1869;"

were passed by the Provincial Council of
the Province of Marlborough, but were re-
served for the signification of the Governor's
pleasure thereon:

Now therefore I, WILLIAM HENRY EYES,
do hereby proclaim and declare that the
above-mentioned Acts having been duly laid
before his Excellency the Governor, and
the Governor having assented to the same,
are, under the provisions of the said
recited Act of the General Assembly, in
full force and authority within the Province
of Marlborough, from the date of this
Proclamation.

Between Arthur Beauchamp, James M'Beth, and William Welford, Plaintiffs; and Godwin George Hood, Defendant,

WHEREAS by a writ of *Fieri Facias* issued in this action, and directed to me, I am commanded of the real and personal estate of the above named defendant to be caused to be made the sum of ninety-two pounds ten shillings and six pence, together with interest upon the said sum at the rate of eight pounds for every hundred pounds by the year, from the first day of May, 1869, together with two pounds (£2) for the said writ, besides sheriff's poundage, officer's fees, and expenses of the said execution.
