BOROUGH OF BLENHEIM.

BYE LAW No. 1 of the Council of the Borough of Blenheim, made under and in pursuance of the powers and provisions contained in Section 181 of "The Municipal Corporation Act, 1867."

"The Council of the Borough of Blenheim ordains as follows, that is to say:--

- The 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 8th Subdivisions of the 1st Part;
- The 2nd Part;
- The 3rd Part;
- The 1st and 2nd Subdivisions of the 7th Part;
- The 1st and 2nd Subdivisions of the 8th Part

The 9th Part;
The 4th Subdivision of the 10th Part; and
The 11th Part,
of the 13th Schedule to the said act, are hereby adopted in and for the said Borough."

WHEREAS the amounts DUE under a Depasturing License, dated the Twenty-seventh day of September, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, made out in the name of HENRY D. WILLIAMS, and by him transferred to CHARLES RUCK KEENE and GEORGE RUCK KEENE jointly, for a Run in the District of Kaikoura, containing 19,500 acres more or less, and a Depasturing License dated the sixteenth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, made out in the joint names of GEORGE ROBERT TURNER and CHARLES HENRY TURNER, and, so far as it relates to that portion of the Ravenscliff Run, which lies to the South-west of a line drawn across the said Run, over the summit of a hill called "Jackson's Head," and contains
