PROCLAMATION.

By his Honor Arthur Penrose Seymour, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough in the Colony of New Zealand, &c., &c., &c.

**W**HEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled "The Provincial Reserved Bills Act, 1858," it is provided that whenever any Bill shall have passed the Provincial Council of any Province, and shall have been reserved for the signification of the Governor's pleasure thereon, such Bill shall not have any force or authority within the said province until the Superintendent shall signify, either by speech or message to the Provincial Council, or by proclamation in the *Government Gazette* of the said Province, that such Bill has been laid before the Governor, and that the Governor has assented to the same:

And whereas a Bill entitled "The Appropriation Act No. 3 1870" was passed by the Provincial Council of the Province of Marlborough, and was reserved for the

signification of the Governor's pleasure thereon:

Now, therefore, I, ARTHUR PENROSE SEYMOUR, the Superintendent of the said Province of Marlborough, do hereby proclaim and declare that the above mentioned Act having been duly laid before his Excellency the Governor, and the Governor having assented to the same, is under the provisions of the said recited Act of the General Assembly, in full force and authority within the Province of Marlborough, from the date of this Proclamation:—
