A PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor Arthur Penrose Seymour,
Esquire, Superintendent of the Province
of Marlborough, in the colony of New
Zealand.

IN pursuance of the powers delegated to me
under the authority of "The Diseased
Cattle Act, 1861," and "The Diseased
Cattle Act Amendment Act, 1865," by
His Excellency the Governor in Council, on
the fourth day of May, 1870, I Arthur
Penrose Seymour, the Superintendent of
the Province of Marlborough, do hereby
declare and proclaim that, on and after the
seventh day of October instant, the District
of Kaikoura—that is to say, all the land
which lies to the South of the Clarence
River in the said Province—shall be
deemed to be an Infected District within
the meaning of the said Acts.

one thousand eight hundred and
seventy-one.

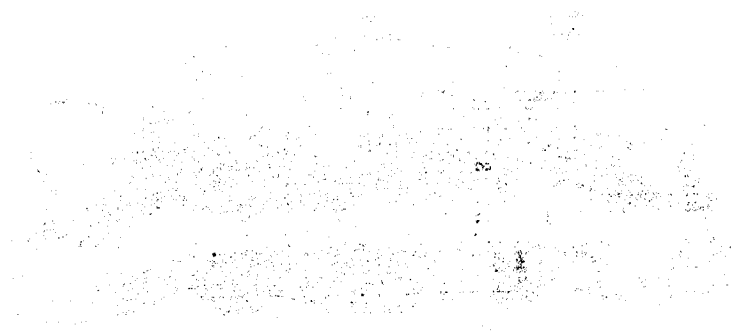
