PROCLAMATION.

By his Honor ARTHUR PENROSE SEYMOUR, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, in the Colony of New Zealand.

**W**HEREAS by a Proclamation issued under my hand and the Public Seal of the Province of Marlborough, on the Twenty-first day of March, 1873, the Provincial Council of the said Province was summoned to meet in the Council Chamber, Blenheim, at Three o'clock in the afternoon on Monday, the Twelfth day of May then next ensuing, and whereas it is expedient to Prorogue the said Provincial Council:
