PROCLAMATION.

By his Honor ARTHUR PENROSE SEYMOUR, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, in the Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by the Third Section of "The Highway Boards Empowering Act, 1871," it is enacted that the Superintendent of any Province, upon the recommendation of the Provincial Council, may from time to time by proclamation declare that any or all of the Parts of the said Act numbered two, three, four, five, six, and seven shall extend and apply to any Highway District constituted or to be constituted by or under any Provincial Act heretofore or hereafter to be passed, or to the inhabitants, ratepayers, or governing body of any such district, as the case may require, and upon such day as shall be fixed in and by any such proclamation, the Part or Parts therein

specified shall be in force in and as to such Highway District, or with regard to the inhabitants, ratepayers, or governing body of such district as the case may require:

And whereas the Provincial Council of the Province of Marlborough did, on the 25th day of April, 1872, pass a resolution recommending the Superintendent of the said Province to proclaim that the second, third, fourth, and sixth Parts of the said recited Act shall extend and apply to the Highway Districts within the said Province: And whereas by a proclamation given under my hand, and issued under the Public Seal of the said Province on the first day of May, 1872, Parts two, three, and six only of the said recited Act were declared to be in force, and Part four has not been proclaimed:

Now, therefore, I, ARTHUR PENROSE SEYMOUR, the Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, do hereby proclaim and declare that Part four of "The High-

way Boards Empowering Act, 1871," shall, upon and after the first day of July, 1874, extend and apply to the Towns of Picton and Havelock, and to the Counties of Picton, Pelorus, Wairau, Awatere, and Kaikoura, in the said Province, and to the Boards of Works and Road Boards of the said Towns and Counties respectively.

Given under my hand, and issued under the Public Seal of the Province of Marlborough, at Blenheim, this Twentieth day of June, One thousand eight hundred and seventy-four.
