PROCLAMATION.

By his Honor ARTHUR PENROSE SEYMOUR, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, in the Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled "The Provincial Reserved Bills Act, 1858," it is enacted that whenever any Bill shall have passed the Provincial Council of any Province, and shall have been reserved for the signification of the Governor's pleasure thereon, such Bill shall not have any force or authority within the said Province until the Superintendent shall signify either by speech or message to the Provincial Council, or by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette* of the said Province, that such Bill has been laid before the Governor, and that the Governor has assented to the same :

And whereas a Bill intituled "The Appropriation Act, 1874," was passed by the Provincial Council of the Province of Marlborough, and was reserved for the

signification of the Governor's pleasure thereon :

Now, therefore, I, ARTHUR PENROSE SEYMOUR, the Superintendent of the said Province of Marlborough, do hereby proclaim and declare, that the above mentioned Bill having been duly laid before his Excellency the Governor, and the Governor having assented to the same, will, under the provisions of the said recited Act of the General Assembly, be in full force and authority within the Province of Marlborough upon the publication of this Proclamation in the *Government Gazette* of the said Province.

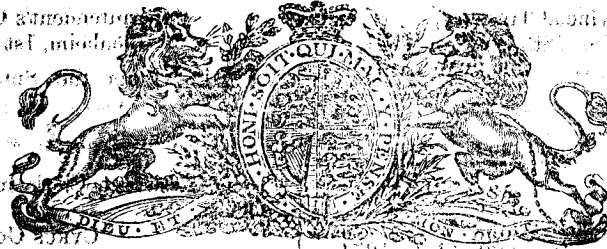

PROCLAMATION.

By his Honor ARTHUR PENROSE SEYMOUR, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, in the Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS, by Clause III. of "The Gold Fields Act, 1866," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor, from time to time, by Proclamation, to constitute and appoint any portion of the Colony to be a Gold Field under the provisions of the said Act, and the limits of such Gold Field from time to time to alter as occasion may require: And whereas, the Governor in Council, under his hand and the Public Seal of the Colony, did, on the Thirtieth day of March, 1874, delegate the said recited power unto me, ARTHUR PENROSE SEYMOUR, Esquire, as Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, to have, hold, and exercise within the said Province: And whereas it is expedient to alter the limits of "The Queen Charlotte Sound Gold Field," in the said Province:

Now, therefore, I, ARTHUR PENROSE SEYMOUR, the Superintendent of the Pro-

vince of Marlborough, do, by this Proclamation, appoint that the boundaries hereinafter mentioned shall henceforth be the limits of "The Queen Charlotte Sound Gold Field," aforesaid, instead of the boundaries defined in a certain Proclamation bearing date the Nineteenth day of October, 1872, given under my hand, and issued under the seal of the said Province.

BOUNDARIES OF THE QUEEN CHARLOTTE SOUND GOLD FIELD.

Towards the South by the Northern boundary of section numbered 111, in the District of Queen Charlotte Sound, from high water mark in Torea Moua Bay, Queen Charlotte Sound, to the watershed between the Queen Charlotte and Pelorus Sounds; thence towards the West by that watershed, to Mount Stokes; thence by the said watershed to the Southern boundary of the Titirangi Run; thence towards the North by that boundary to high water mark in Melville Cove, Port Gore Bay; thence again towards the South and West by the waters of Port Gore Bay, to Jack-

son's Head; and thence towards the East by high-water mark, Queen Charlotte Sound, to the starting point in Torea Moua Bay, excepting "The Ravenscliff Gold Field," all the freehold lands, Native and other reserves, and lands held under Departurage Licences and Leases, within the aforesaid boundaries.

Given under my hand, at Wellington, this Eighth day of August, One thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, and issued under the Public Seal of the Province of Marlborough, at Blenheim.

BYELAW No. 3

Of the Borough of Blenheim, made under and in pursuance of the powers and provisions contained in "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1867."
