IN accordance with Clause 8 of "The Marlborough Waste Lands Act, 1867," it is hereby notified that the under-mentioned lands have been Reserved under Clause 7 of the said Act:—

All that parcel of land in the District of Kaikoura Suburban, bounded towards the North and East by the Kincaid Run, and Section 47 on the said Run, from the River Waimanarara, to the line of road forming part of the Northern boundary of Section 38 on the said Run; thence by the Northern side of the last-mentioned road to a point in transit with the boundary between Sections 175 and 176, in the said district; thence towards

the East by a right line from the last-named point to the Northern side of the road forming the Northern boundary of Sections 173, 174, and 175 in the said district, to the stream before mentioned; thence towards the West by that stream to the starting point.—For protection of River Banks.

All the unsold portion, being part 2, of Section 267, in the District of Kaikoura Suburban, containing about 29 acres.—As a Public Recreation Ground.
