NOTICE.

IN accordance with the provisions of an Act of the Provincial Council of the Province of Marlborough, intituled "The Public Cemeteries Acts Amendment Act, 1875," I, JAMES EDMUND HODSON, Esquire, Deputy Superintendent of the said Province, do hereby, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Province, set apart the parcels of land hereinafter described, as Public Cemeteries, to be called respectively the "Upper Wairau Cemetery," and the "Kaituna Cemetery," namely:—

The Upper Wairau Cemetery comprises all that parcel of land in the District of Omaka, being a triangular block containing 6a. 1r. 10p., more or less, forming part of Section numbered 133 on the Plan of the said district: bounded towards the north 748 links by a public road; towards the east by a public road; and towards the west 1,689 links by public road numbered 182 on the said plan.

The Kaituna Cemetery comprises all that parcel of land in the District of Kaituna Valley, being a rectangular block 500 links by 1,000 links, forming part of Section numbered 67 on the Plan of the said District of Kaituna Valley.

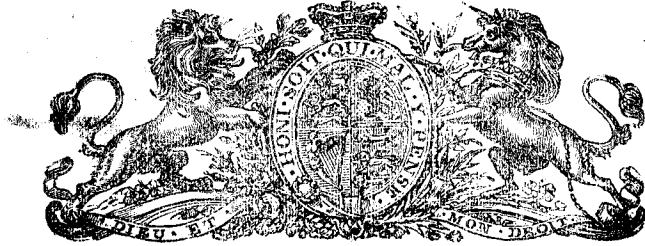
