## EXCESS OF EXPENDITURE (1853-54) ORDINANCE.

In the Eighteenth Year of the Reign of  
Her Majesty Queen Victoria.

SESSION II., No. 6.

### ANALYSIS.

#### Preamble.

1. Provincial Treasurer to be allowed to take credit for sums expended beyond the amount authorised by Appropriation Ordinances.

AN ORDINANCE to authorise the Provincial Treasurer to take credit for certain sums paid for the services of the Government in excess of the sums allowed by the "Appropriation Ordinance," Session I., No. 2, and the "Appropriation Ordinance (Supplementary)" Session I., No. 7, of the Provincial Council of Otago.

**WHEREAS** various sums of money have been necessarily expended for the service of the Government of the Province of Otago during the year ending on the thirtieth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four, beyond the amounts duly authorised to have been expended, in consequence of the Estimates for said year having been prepared without the requisite experience, and it is now expedient that the Provincial Treasurer be authorised to take credit for the money expended.

**BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED** by the Superintendent of the said Province, with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof, as follows:—

1. The Provincial Treasurer shall be allowed, and is hereby authorised, to take credit in his accounts for the several sums of money beyond the amounts respectively authorised by the

said "Appropriation Ordinance," Session I., No. 2, and the "Appropriation Ordinance (Supplementary)" Session I., No. 7, which have been or shall be paid in pursuance of warrants by the Superintendent, for the public service of the year ending at 30th September 1854, to the extent specified in the Schedule hereunto annexed, and the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same were or shall be so paid, shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his accounts for any such sum or sums of money as shall be therein mentioned.

**QUALIFICATION OF VOTERS.**

"Every man of the age of twenty-one years and upwards, having a Freehold Estate in possession, situate within the District for which the Vote is to be given, of the clear value of Fifty Pounds above all charges and incumbrances, and of or to which he has been seised or entitled, either at law or in equity, for at least six calendar months next before the last Registration of Electors; or having a Leasehold Estate in possession situate within such District, of the clear annual value of Ten Pounds, held upon a Lease which at the date of such Registration shall not have less than three years to run; or having a Leasehold Estate so situate, and of such value as aforesaid, of which he has been in possession for three years or upwards next before such Registration; or being a Householder within such District, occupying a tenement within the limits of the Town, of the clear annual value of Ten Pounds, or without the limits of the Town, of the clear annual value of Five Pounds, having resided therein six calendar months next before such Registration as aforesaid, shall, if duly registered, be entitled to vote at the Election of a Superintendent of a Province, or of a Member or Members of the Provincial Council thereof, or of a Member or Members of the House of Representatives: Provided that he is not an alien, and that he has not at any time heretofore been attainted or convicted of any treason, felony, or any infamous offence within any part of Her Majesty's dominions, unless he shall have received a free pardon, or shall have undergone the sentence or punishment to which he shall have been adjudged for such offence."

"Every person claiming to be enrolled under the qualification of being a householder shall prefer his claim to be enrolled within the district in which the tenement occupied

"by him is situated in respect of which he claims; and every person claiming to be enrolled in respect of any other qualification shall prefer his claim to be enrolled within any district in which any part of his property on which he claims to be enrolled is situated; provided always, that where any person has property situated in two or more districts sufficient in the aggregate to qualify him to be an elector, he may prefer his claim to be enrolled in any one or more of the districts in which his property is situated, although the property held by him in that particular district for which he claims should not be sufficient of itself to qualify him; provided further, that no person can be enrolled in any district in respect of any property on which he claims in whole or in part to be enrolled in any other district."
