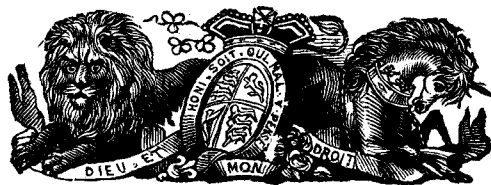

#### PROCLAMATION.

##### *Appointment of Kerosene Warehouse.*

By His Honor JAMES PATERSON, Deputy-Superintendent of the Province of Otago.

WHEREAS the Warehouse hereinafter mentioned has been approved of by me as a secure and fit place for the storing and keeping Kerosene and Paraffine Oils: Now, therefore, I, James Paterson, Esquire, Deputy-Superintendent of the Province of Otago by virtue of the powers vested in me in this behalf do hereby proclaim, declare, and appoint the building now standing and erected on section numbered 7, of block VII., of the Town District, Anderson's Bay Road, and near the Dunedin Gas Works, to be a Public Kerosene Warehouse, for the purposes of the "Kerosene and Paraffine Oils Ordinance 1863," and the "Kerosene and Paraffine Oils Ordinance 1863 Amendment Ordinance 1864." And also, I do appoint

of Rattray-street, Dunedin, to be Keeper of the said Public Kerosene Warehouse.
