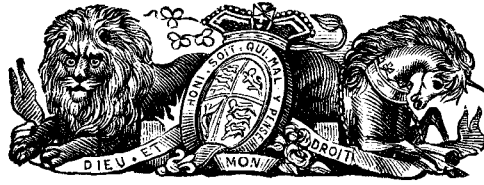

published in conformity with the provisions of  
"The Execution of Criminals Act, 1858."

I, Edward Hulme, the medical officer in attendance  
at the Execution of William Andrew Jarvey, at the  
Gaol of Dunedin, do hereby certify and declare that I  
have this day witnessed the Execution of the said  
William Andrew Jarvey at this Gaol; and I  
do further certify and declare that the said  
William Andrew Jarvey was, in pursuance of the  
sentence of the Supreme Court, hanged by the neck  
until his body was dead.

Given under my hand this twenty-fourth day  
of October, in the year one thousand eight  
hundred and sixty-five, at the Gaol of  
Dunedin.

EDWARD HULME, M.D.

We do hereby certify and declare that we have  
this day been present when the extreme penalty of  
the law was carried into execution on the body of  
William Andrew Jarvey, convicted at the Criminal  
Session of the Supreme Court, held at Dunedin on  
the eleventh and subsequent days of September, one  
thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, and sentenced  
to death, and that the said William Andrew Jarvey  
was, in pursuance of the said sentence, hanged by the  
neck until his body was dead.

the year one thousand eight hundred and  
sixty-five, at the Gaol of Dunedin.
