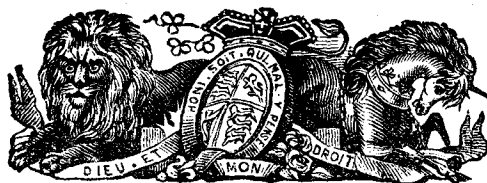

## PROCLAMATION

*Of the Alterations of the Boundaries of the Milton and Hillingdon Road Districts.*

By His Honor BRYAN CECIL HAGGITT, Esquire,  
Deputy-Superintendent of the Province of Otago.

WHEREAS by an Ordinance passed by the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Otago, intituled the "Otago Roads Ordinance, 1865," it is amongst other things enacted in the fifth Section thereof—That for the purposes of the said Ordinance, so much of the said Province as is subject to the provisions of the said Ordinance may from time to time be divided into districts, and until otherwise provided, pursuant to the provisions of the now recited Ordinance, there shall be sixty-one districts, which should be named as specified in the Schedule to the said Ordinance annexed, marked B: And it is also by the said fifth section provided that it shall be lawful for the Superintendent, with the advice and consent of the General Road Board, from time to time, by proclamation in the *Gazette*, to alter, vary, diminish, or enlarge the boundaries of any or all of such districts,

And whereas it is deemed advisable to alter the boundaries of the Milton and Hillingdon Road Districts by diminishing the boundaries of the Milton Road District, and enlarging the boundaries of the Hillingdon Road District in the manner and as described in the Schedules hereto; Now therefore I, Bryan Cecil Haggitt, Deputy-Superintendent of the said Province, with the advice and consent of the Otago General Road Board, do hereby proclaim and declare that the boundaries of the said Milton Road District shall from the day and date hereof be altered and diminished, and that the boundaries of the said district shall henceforth be as described in the first Schedule hereto: And I do hereby further proclaim and declare that the boundaries of the said Hillingdon Road District shall, from the day and date hereof, be altered and enlarged, and that the boundaries of the said district shall henceforth be as described in the second Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE I.

THE MILTON ROAD DISTRICT shall comprise all that area bounded on the north-west by sections 50, 49, and 48, block II, Table Hill Survey District, block XXIII, Tokomairiro Survey District, and section 198, block XXV, Tokomairiro Survey District; on the south-west by Tokomairiro River to section 8, block XXX, Tokomairiro Survey District, section 1, block XXXII, and parts sections 3 and 11, and section 4, block XXXI, Tokomairiro Survey District, sections 32, 20, and 19, block I, Kaitangata to Tokomairiro River, thence by said river to south-east angle of section 30, block VI, Akatore; on the east by section 29, block VI, Akatore; on the south by sections 29, 28, and part section 27, block VI, Akatore, on the east by sections 22, 19, 17, 15, 13, 11, 9, parts of 7, 30, 4, and 3, block I, Akatore; on the north-east by section 2, block I, Akatore, section 86, block X, Tokomairiro Survey District, sections 93 and 98, block XI, sections 105 and 110, block XII, section 117, block XIII, and section 127, block XV, Tokomairiro Survey District.

## SCHEDULE II.

THE HILLINGDON ROAD DISTRICT shall comprise all that area bounded on the north by block II, Akatore Survey District; on the west by sections 10 and 12, block I, Akatore; on the north by sections 12 and 11, block I, Akatore; on the west by part section 31, sections 32, 33, and 23, block I, Akatore; on the north by part section 23, said block I; on the west by section 30, block VI, Akatore; on the south by the Tokomairiro River to the ocean; on the south-east by the ocean; and on the east by the Koaura or Shag Creek.

WHEREAS by an Ordinance passed by the Superintendent and the Provincial Council of the Province of Otago, intituled the "Otago Roads Ordinance, 1865," it is amongst other things enacted that until otherwise provided, pursuant to the provisions of the said Ordinance, there should be sixty-one Districts, which should be named as specified in the Schedule to the said Ordinance annexed, marked B: And it is also by the said Ordinance provided that it should be lawful for the Superintendent, with the advice and consent of the Otago General Road Board, from time to time, by Proclamation in the *Gazette*, to alter, vary, diminish, or enlarge the boundaries of any or all of such Districts: And whereas it is expedient to alter and diminish the boundaries of the Warepa District in manner and as described in Schedule hereto;—Now therefore I, Bryan Cecil Haggitt, Deputy-Superintendent of the said Province, with the advice and consent of the Otago General Road Board, do hereby proclaim and declare that the boundaries of the said Warepa Road District shall, from the day of the date hereof, be altered and diminished, and that the boundaries of the Warepa Road District shall henceforth be as described in the Schedule hereto.

**SCHEDULE.**

WAREPA ROAD DISTRICT shall comprise all that area bounded on the north by the Southern Trunk Road; on the east by road line, from Port Molyneux Road to Warepa Road, to north-east angle of section 6, block XXX, Clutha Survey District, and sections 5, 3, 1, block XXX, and sections 11, 9, 7, 5, and 3, block XXIX, Clutha Survey District, to the Puerua River; on the south-east by the Puerua River to southern boundary line of block I, Warepa; south and south-west by southern boundary of block I, Warepa, southern boundaries of sections 15 and 14, block II, Warepa; on the west by western boundary of section 14, block II, Warepa, to Trig. Station G, thence by the southern boundary of block II, Warepa, to Kaihiku Stream; on the west by the eastern boundary of the Kaihiku District to Main South Road.

**PROCLAMATION.**

*Road Districts of Waiwera and Te Houka formed.*

By His Honor BRYAN CECIL HAGGITT, Esquire,  
Deputy-Superintendent of the Province of Otago.

WHEREAS by an Ordinance, passed by the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Otago, intituled the "Otago Roads Ordinance, 1865," it is amongst other things enacted that, until otherwise provided, pursuant to the provisions of the said Ordinance there should be sixty-one districts which should be named as specified in the Schedule to the said Ordinance annexed, marked B: And it is also by the said Ordinance provided that it should be lawful for the Superintendent, with the advice and consent of the Otago General Road Board, from time to time, by Proclamation in the *Gazette*, to alter, vary, diminish, or enlarge the boundaries of any or all of such districts, and to increase the number of districts by forming and naming new districts:

And whereas it is expedient to form two new Road Districts to be named respectively the Waiwera and

Te Houka Road Districts;—Now therefore I, Bryan Cecil Haggitt, Esquire, Deputy-Superintendent of the Province of Otago, with the advice and consent of the Otago General Road Board, do hereby proclaim and declare that the area bounded as described in the first Schedule hereto shall, from the day of the date hereof, be constituted a Road District, and shall be named the Waiwera Road District; and that the area bounded as described in the second Schedule hereto shall, from the day of the date hereof, be constituted a Road District, and shall be named the Te Houka Road District.

**SCHEDULE I.**

THE WAIWERA ROAD DISTRICT shall comprise all that area bounded on the north by portion of block V; and on the west by portion of block VII, Pomahaka Survey District, and the Waiwera River to the boundary of the Hundreds; south, by the boundary of the Hundreds to block III, Warepa Survey District, then following western boundary of sections 1 and 6, block III, Warepa Survey District to road line; south, by said road line to southern angle of section 11, block III, Warepa, thence by a line bearing north to the south-east angle of section 10, block CIV, Clutha Survey District; east by section 9, block CIV, sections 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, block XCIII, Clutha Survey District, sections 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, block XCIV, Clutha Survey District, sections 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, block XCV, Clutha Survey District, sections 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, block XCVI, Clutha Survey District.

**SCHEDULE II.**

TE HOUKA ROAD DISTRICT shall comprise all that area bounded on the north by the Clutha River; on the south-east and south by the Southern Trunk Road to the eastern boundary of the Kaihiku District; on the west by the eastern boundary of the Kaihiku District; thence on the south by block LXXXIV, section 11 and part section 12, block LXXXVIII, Clutha Survey District; thence west by a road line continuing through block IV, Pomahaka to Totara Island on said Clutha River.

THE WAKARI ROAD DISTRICT shall comprise all that area bounded towards the North by the Northern boundary of block V., Dunedin and East Taieri Survey District; towards the west by block IV, and section 50, block VI, Dunedin and East Taieri Survey District; towards the south by section 160, Wakari Survey District, and the Kaikorai Stream; towards the south-east by a road line bounding sections 10 to 17, block IV, Upper Kaikorai, and section 8, block III, Upper Kaikorai; towards the south-west by sections 6, 4, and 2, block III, and 4, block I, Upper Kaikorai; and again towards the south-east by the Town Belt of Dunedin, and towards the east by the Water of Leith.
