No. 21.

1. One hundred and twenty-six chains in length, sixty links wide from District Road between sections four and ten, block ten, Inch Clutha. Boundaries: North and East, Matau River; South, sections ten, eleven, and twelve, block ten, Inch Clutha.

No. 23.—Road Divers'ion Ordinance, 1865.

1. Forty-five Chains in length, 1 chain wide, from N.E. angle of Sec. 59, Block 3, Maungatua District, to District Road on Sec. 39, Block 3, Maungatua District. Boundaries: E., Secs. 40, 41, 42, and part of 39, Block 3, Maungatua, W. and S. by Secs. 59, 58, part of 57, Block 3, Maungatua.

2. Fifty chains in length, 60 links wide from District Road on Sec. 13 River Sec. Taieri to Road on Sec. 13 River Sec. Taieri. Boundaries: W. part of River Sec. 13; E. Taieri River.

3. Thirty-two chains in length, 60 links wide from Road on River, Sec. 14, Taieri, to Road on River, Sec. 15. Boundaries: W. River Sec. 14 and part of 15, E. Taieri River.

4. Ninety chains in length, sixty links wide, from District Road, between River sections twelve and fourteen to District Road on River section nineteen; Boundaries: east, River sections fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, and part of nineteen; west, part of block three, Maungatua District.

5. Fifty-three chains in length, sixty links wide, from District Road between River section nineteen, block three, Maungatua, to road on river bank at section nineteen. Boundaries: both sides, river section nineteen.

6. Thirty-six chains in length, sixty links wide, from District Road between River section twenty-nine, Taieri, and section one, block one, Taieri Survey District, to new District Road on section twenty-nine. Boundaries: west, sections seven and fifteen, block three, Maungatua Survey District; east, sections eight and fourteen, said block and district.

4. Sixty-nine chains in length, sixty links wide, from District Road between section four, block three, Maungatua Survey District, and section seven, River Sections, Taieri, to New Main District Road, forming northern boundary of section nineteen, block three, Maungatua Survey District. Boundaries: west, sections four and twenty, block three, Maungatua Survey District; east, sections five and nineteen, said block and district.

5. Six chains in length, sixty links wide, from District Road between section fourteen, block three, Maungatua Survey District, and section one, Irregular Block, Taieri. Boundaries: west, section fifteen, block three, Maungatua Survey District; east, section one, Irregular Block, Taieri.

6. Forty-eight chains in length, one chain wide, from eastern boundary of section twenty-three, block three, Maungatua Survey District, to New District Road through section twenty-two, said block and district. Boundaries: north, section twenty-three and part of section twenty-two, block three, Maungatua Survey District; south, sections fifteen, sixteen, and New Main District Road, said block and section.

7. Twenty-eight chains in length, one chain wide, from New District Road through section twenty-two, block three, Maungatua Survey District, to Main District Road between sections thirty-five and forty-three, said block and district. Boundaries: north, part sections twenty-two and thirty-four; west, section thirty-five and part section thirty-four, South New Main District Road; east, part section twenty and New Main District Road, block three, Maungatua Survey District.

Forty-seven chains in length, sixty links wide, from New Main District Road on section one, River Sections, Taieri, to District Road between section even, River Sections, Taieri, and section three, block three, Maungatua Survey District. CROWN GRANTS for the Land, and in favor of the persons after-mentioned, are now ready for issue; and attention is directed to the following clauses of the "Crown Grants Act, 1866," passed during the last session of the General Assembly, which came into operation on the 8th October last:—

Clause XXXIX.—There shall be paid upon all Grants to be hereafter issued, which may be left in the charge or custody of any Commissioner of Crown Lands, or other officer charged with the delivery of the same, a fee of sixpence for every month during which they shall have been so left after the expiration of three months from the date of the notice in the *Gazette* of the Province wherein the lands are situate, that such Grants are ready for delivery.

Clause XL.—There shall be paid upon all Grants issued prior to the passing of this Act, and left as aforesaid in the custody of the officer charged with the delivery thereof, a fee of sixpence per month for every
