"No holder of a license to depasture cattle upon the unfenced pasture lands within the Mokoreta Hundred, shall be entitled to depasture a greater number than Two head of great cattle, or Ten head of small cattle for every acre of land which he shall own or occupy, without the consent in writing of the Wardens."
