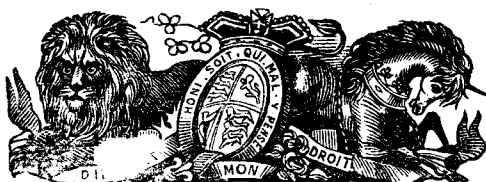

PROCLAMATION

Fixing and Appointing the Resident Magistrate's Court at "Black's," as the place for holding Quarterly Licensing Meetings in the Licensing District of St. Bathans.

By His Honor JAMES MACANDREW, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Otago.

WHEREAS by Section XII of the "Licensing Ordinance, 1866," it is enacted (amongst other things) that if at any time there shall be more than one Resident Magistrate's Court, usually holden within any Licensing District, the Superintendent shall, by Proclamation published in the *Government Gazette* of the said Province, fix and appoint at which of the Courts within the Licensing District the Quarterly Licensing Meetings thereafter mentioned should be held:

Now therefore I, James Macandrew, Superintendent of the Province of Otago, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in me in this behalf, do hereby fix and appoint the Resident Magistrate's Court, at "Black's," as the Court at which the Quarterly Licensing Meetings for the "St. Bathans Licensing District" shall be held.
