## BASE COPPER COIN.

**T**HE following Section (being 15) of "The Coinage Offences Act 1867," is published for general information:—

"15. Whosoever shall tender utter or put off any false or counterfeit coin resembling or apparently intended to resemble or pass for any of the Queen's current copper coin knowing the same to be false or counterfeit or shall have in his custody or possession

three or more pieces of false or counterfeit coin resembling or apparently intended to resemble or pass for any of the Queen's current copper coin knowing the same to be false or counterfeit and with intent to utter or put off the same or any of them shall be guilty of a misdemeanour and being convicted thereof shall be liable at the discretion of the court to be imprisoned for any term not exceeding one year with or without hard labor and with or without solitary confinement."
