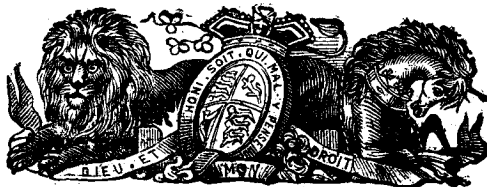

PROCLAMATION.

Cancellation of Lease to Depasture Stock on certain Crown Lands in the Province of Otago.

By His Honor W. A. Tolmie, Deputy-Superintendent of the Province of Otago, in Council

WHEREAS by the sixteenth section of the "Gold Fields Act 1866," it is enacted that when any Gold Mine or Gold Field shall be discovered and proclaimed upon any Crown Lands, which at the date of the passing of the said Act shall have been held under lease for depasturing purposes, it should be lawful for the Governor, at his discretion, to cancel the lease under which such land shall have been held in occupation, as regards the whole or any part of the lands so held under such or lease, or with the concurrence of the lessee, to suspend such lease as regards the whole or any part of such lands:

And whereas Thomas Dick, Esquire, then Superintendent of the Province of Otago, by virtue and in exercise of the powers delegated to and vested in him in that behalf, did, by Proclamation in the Government Gazette of the said Province, bearing date the twenty-ninth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, constitute and appoint all the territory therein described, including amongst other lands the lands hereinafter described, to be a Gold Field under the provisions of the "Gold Fields Act 1866," to be called "Otago Gold Field." And whereas by the "Gold Fields Act Amendment Act 1867," it is enacted that within any Province in which by any Act or Ordinance it is provided that the Superintendent shall, in the administration of the Government thereof, act by and with the advice and consent of an Executive Council, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council,

under his hand, and under the public seal of the Colony, from time to time, as occasion may require, to delegate to the Executive Government for the time being of such Province, subject or not to any restrictions or limitations, as he may think fit, all or any of such powers vested in the Governor, or the Governor in Council, by the "Gold Fields Act 1866," as under, or by virtue of the one hundred and ninth section of the said Act may be delegated by the Governor in Council, and in like manner to revoke any such delegation: And whereas by an Ordinance of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Otago, intituled the "Executive Council Ordinance 1861," it is provided that the Superintendent of the said Province shall, in the administration of the Government thereof, act by and with the advice and consent of an Executive Council: And whereas the Governor hath, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of New Zealand, and in pursuance of the power and authority for that purpose vested in him by the "Gold Fields Act 1866," and subject to its provisions delegated unto the Executive Government for the time being of the Province of Otago, all such powers vested in the Governor, or the Governor in Council, by the said last-mentioned Act, as under or by virtue of the one hundred and ninth section of the said last-mentioned Act, may be delegated by the Governor in Council, to have, hold, and exercise the said powers within the said Province of Otago: And whereas the said lands hereinafter described are Crown Lands, subject to be dealt with under the provisions of the said sixteenth section of the "Gold Fields Act 1866," and the said lands are now, or lately were, held in occupation by David M'Kellar under a lease for depasturing purposes, issued under the "Otago Waste Lands Act 1866," and bearing date the 4th day of September, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven:

And whereas the Executive Government of the Province of Otago have determined to cancel the said lease as to so much and such part of the lands held under the same as are comprised within the area hereinafter described :

Now therefore I, William Alexander Tolmie, Deputy-Superintendent of the Province of Otago, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Province, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers delegated to the Executive Government of the said Province in this behalf by His Excellency the Governor of New Zealand in Council, under the authority of the "Gold Fields Act Amendment Act 1867," and of any and every other power in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby cancel the said lease, in so far as the lands comprised within the area hereinafter described are affected by the said lease, but no further or otherwise (that is to say)—

All that area in the Province of Otago, Colony of New Zealand, containing by admeasurement five hundred and six (506) acres two (2) roods and six (6) poles, more or less, situate in the Wendon district, being sections numbered 11, 12, 13, 15, 17, 18, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28 and 39, block I, on the map of the said district : bounded towards the north-east and north-west by Domeburn, nine thousand (9000) links, towards the south-east by section numbered 16 and a road line one thousand one hundred and thirty-five (1135) links, and section numbered 14, two thousand two hundred and eighty-seven (2287) links, also a road line five hundred and thirty (530) links ; towards the north-east by a road line four thousand and fifty-nine (4059) links, and section numbered 14, one thousand and twenty-two (1022) links, also a road line six hundred and twenty-five (625) links ; towards the north-east and south-east by a road line six thousand eight hundred (6800) links; towards the south-west by a road line four thousand one hundred and four (4104) links, section numbered 40, three thousand three hundred and twenty-nine (3329) links, and a road line four thousand six hundred (4600) links ; towards the north-west by a road line, sections numbered 23 and 29, and a road line six thousand and sixty-three (6063) links, and part of section numbered 38, one thousand six hundred and forty-eight (1648) links, intersected by a road one hundred (100) links wide, and also a road fifty (50) links wide.

Also, all that area in the Province of Otago afore said, containing by admeasurement one hundred and forty one (141 acres two (2) roods and thirty-eight (38) poles, more or less, situate in the Wendon District, being sections numbered 1, 2, and 3, block I, on the map of the said district : bounded towards the north-east by section numbered 4, three thousand three hundred and thirty-six (3336) links ; towards the north-east, south-east, and south-west by a road line and Garvie Creek, eight thousand three hundred (8300) links ; towards the north-west by a road line three thousand nine hundred and eight (3908) links.

Given under my hand and issued under the Public Seal of the Province of Otago, at Dunedin, in presence of George Duncan, Donald Reid, and John Lillie Gillies, Esqs., three of the members of the Executive Council of the said Province, being also members of the Provincial Council thereof, this twenty-ninth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and seventy.

SIRS,—We, the undersigned Settlers and Residents of North Molyneux, do humbly show that in consequence of the coastal steamer having been withdrawn from service, we are greatly inconvenienced, besides being put to unusual loss and expense in the forwarding of our produce and goods to the Dunedin markets, and as sailing crafts arrive and embark at uncertain times, no dependence can be placed on them.

It frequently happens, too, that the long delay occasioned between the interval of shipping at Port Molyneux and the landing at Dunedin, that prices have fallen, which causes many to become serious losers, and which might be prevented by having a quicker and more certain mode of transit for our goods.
