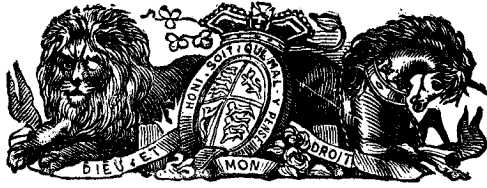


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PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor James Macandrew, Superintendent of the Province of Otago.

**I**, JAMES MACANDREW, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Otago, do, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in the Superintendent of the Province of Otago in this behalf by the "Roads Diversion Ordinance 1871, and of the powers vested in me as Superintendent of the Province of Otago, hereby proclaim and declare that all those roads and all those portions of roads in the Province of Otago, mentioned and referred to in the said "Roads Diversion Ordinance 1871," and particularly described in the Schedule hereto, shall, from and after the day of the date hereof, cease to be public roads or thoroughfares, and shall no longer form part of the public roads in the several Road Districts in the Province of Otago, mentioned in the Schedule to the said Ordinance annexed.

*Allday Road District. (No. 1.)*

1. All that area in the Province of Otago, containing by admeasurement 4a 0r 32p, more or less, situate in block III, Otepopo District: bounded towards the north by sections 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8, eight thousand four hundred (8400) links, more or less; and towards the south by sections 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19, eight thousand four hundred (8400) links, more or less.

2. All that area in the Province of Otago, containing by admeasurement 5a 1r 32p, more or less, situate in block II, Otepopo District: bounded towards the north by parts of sections 8, 7, 6, and 103, block II, and section 66, block III, ten thousand eight hundred (10,800) links, more or less; and towards the south by other part of section 66, block III, and other parts of sections 103, 6, 7, and 8, ten thousand eight hundred (10,800) links, more or less.

3. All that area in the Province of Otago, containing by admeasurement 1a 2r 24p, more or less, situate in block II, Otepopo Survey District: bounded towards the south-east by section 9, three thousand three hundred and twenty (3320) links, more or less; and towards the north-west by section 3, three thousand three hundred (3300) links, more or less.

4. All that area in the Province of Otago, containing by admeasurement 3a 0r 16p, more or less, situate in block V, Otepopo Survey District: bounded towards the south-east by parts of sections 74, 55, 56, 57, and 58, six thousand two hundred and fifty (6250) links, more or less; and towards the north-west by other portions of sections 74, 55, 56, 57, and 58, six thousand two hundred (6200) links, more or less.

5. All that area in the Province of Otago, containing by admeasurement 1a 1r 0p, more or less, situate in block V, Otepopo Survey District: bounded towards the east by parts of sections 57, 58 and 59, two thousand five hundred and thirty (2530) links; and towards the west by other parts of said sections 57, 58 and 59, two thousand five hundred (2500) links, more or less.

6. All that area in the Province of Otago, containing by admeasurement 1a 3r 8p, more or less, situate in block V, Otepopo Survey District: bounded towards the north-west by part of section 94, three thousand six hundred (3600) links, more or less; and towards the south-west by other part of section 94, three thousand six hundred (3600) links, more or less.

*Anderson's Bay Road District. (No. 2.)*

2. All that area in the Province of Otago, containing by admeasurement 1a 0r 27p, more or less, situate in Anderson's Bay Survey District: bounded towards the north-east by sections 1, 2, 3 and 4, one thousand nine hundred and fifty (1950) links; and towards the south-

west by section 8, block VI, one thousand nine hundred (1900) links, more or less.

3. All that area in the Province of Otago, containing by admeasurement 1a 3r 8p, more or less, situate in Anderson's Bay Survey District: bounded towards the south-east by sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8, block VI, three thousand (3000) links; and towards the north-west by sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8, block V, three thousand (3000) links, more or less.

*Awamoa Road District. (No. 3.)*

*Catlin's River Road District. (No. 4.)*

*Highcliffe Road District. (No. 10).*

All that area in the Province of Otago, containing by admeasurement 1a 3r 12p, more or less, situate in block I, Otago Peninsula Survey District: bounded towards the north by parts of sections 35 and 17, three thousand six hundred (3600) links, more or less, and towards the south by other parts of sections 35 and 17, three thousand six hundred (3600) links, more or less.

2. All that area in the Province of Otago, containing by admeasurement 3r 16p, more or less, situate in block I, Otago Peninsula Survey District: bounded towards the east by section 14, nine hundred (900) links; and towards the west by section 35, eight hundred (800) links.

3. All that area in the Province of Otago, containing by admeasurement 3a 0r 32p, more or less, situate in block I, Otago Peninsula Survey District: bounded towards the east by section 39, three thousand two hundred and twenty (3220) links; and towards the west by section 35, three thousand one hundred and eighty (3180) links.

4. *Merton Road District. (No. 12).*

6. All that area in the Province of Otago, containing by admeasurement 2a 1r 24p, more or less, situate in block II, Hawksbury Survey District: bounded towards the east by parts of sections 34, 35, and 36, four thousand eight hundred (4800) links, more or less; and towards the west by other parts of sections 34, 35 and

36, four thousand nine hundred (4900) links, more or less.

*North Molyneux District. (No. 15).*

*North-east Harbor District. (No. 16).*

#### TO SCHOOL COMMITTEES AND SCHOOL TEACHERS.

**T**HE following Minute of the Education Board is published for the information of School Committees and School Teachers.

The Board having carefully considered the Education Statistics for the year 1871, as contained in the Returns compiled by the Secretary, resolved—

1. That the following Regulations take effect on and after the first day of October, 1872:—

- (1.) The Board will pay two-thirds of the cost of Pupil Teachers, including the payments to Masters for their Education, instead of the whole cost as at present.
- (2.) The Board will pay two-thirds of the Fees for the Education of Orphan and Destitute Children, instead of the whole cost as at present.
- (3.) The District Schools will be classified somewhat as follows;—

- (a.) Grammar Schools, as provided by Ordinance.
- (b.) Main Schools—Teacher's Salary, £100; must have an average attendance of 40 pupils at least.
- (c.) Side Schools—Teacher's Salary, £75; must have an average attendance of 25 pupils at least.
- (d.) Temporarily Subsidised Schools, £60; to be discontinued or connected with another Half-time School, if attendance does not eventually reach 20.
- (e.) Schools under Itinerant Teachers, if such can possibly be established.

- (4.) No school shall be recognised as a Main School or a Side School unless the returns for the preceding year show an average attendance for such year of at least 40 pupils in the case of a Main School, or 25 pupils in the case of a Side School. All schools at present ranking as Main or Side Schools which do not fulfil the required conditions as to attendance, will be brought under this rule, although a reduction in point of rank be the consequence, but due regard will be had to the professional status and merits of the present teachers in the adjustment of salaries. The payment of salary as specified above, will only be rigidly adhered to on the appointment of a new teacher, or when a falling off in the attendance is fairly and clearly attributable to the inefficiency or negligence of the teacher.
- (5.) The following average attendance respectively will be required before the Board will consider applications for salaries for additional teachers:—

- (a.) For a schoolmistress at £60, there must be at least 75 pupils.
- (b.) For a schoolmistress with a pupil teacher, 110 pupils.
- (c.) For a sewing teacher at £25, 50 pupils.
- (d.) For a pupil teacher alone, 55 pupils.

- (6.) To secure payment of a schoolmistress' salary the school committee must undertake to pay to her at least £25 per annum in addition to the Board's allowance; in the case of a teacher of sewing, the committee must undertake to pay £10 in addition to the Board's allowance; and before the employment of a pupil teacher is sanctioned, the school committee must undertake to pay one third of the total cost of such pupil teacher.

2. That the Inspector be instructed to make the fullest possible investigations during his next round of inspection as to the practicability of lessening the cost of the smaller schools, and of also meeting the educational wants of sparsely peopled districts by a system of half-time schools, and the employment of itinerant teachers.

3. That the Inspector be instructed to submit in his report for the year 1872 suggestions as to the best mode for enabling the Board to judge of the results of the year's teaching in each school, and for enabling the Board, with the consent of the Provincial Council to bestow honorary grants of money upon the most meritorious teachers; such grants to be bestowed strictly in accordance with well-ascertained results.

4. That the Board express their satisfaction at the comparatively large sums contributed towards the teachers' salaries and other school expenses in many of the school districts, and also their regret that in some districts the amounts contributed locally bear so very small a proportion to the moneys advanced to such districts from the Provincial revenue, and strongly recommend to School Committees and the inhabitants generally of the different school districts, that strenuous efforts be made to secure that every school teacher shall

receive from the district a sum equal at the very least to one-half of the amount contributed by the Board towards such teacher's salary.

5. That the Board approve generally of the changes proposed by the Secretary in the Schedule submitted by him.

IV. That no person shall be allowed to depasture on the Hundred more than one head of cattle for every five acres of land in his occupation, and that all cattle so depastured must be branded with the registered brand of the license-holder.

V. That all stray cattle, and cattle depastured in contravention of any of the foregoing Bye-laws, may be impounded, and that the Wardens will not be responsible for any mistakes which may arise through cattle not bearing brands according to the "Cattle Branding Ordinance."

VI. That the penalty for any breach of the foregoing Bye-laws be any sum not exceeding five pounds sterling, to be recovered in a summary way according to the 45th clause of the Land Regulations.

VII. That nothing contained in the above Bye-laws shall be held or construed to authorise the impounding of sheep or cattle, or the enforcing penalties from the owners of any sheep or cattle which are being depastured on any land, whether fenced or not, which is the property of, or is lawfully occupied by the owner of such sheep or cattle.

**WHEREAS** by "The Immigration and Public Works Act, 1870," it is among other things enacted that the Governor may, at the request of the Superintendent of any Province, from time to time make regulations (as therein mentioned) for the conduct of immigration under the said Act into such Province, and for the nomination of Immigrants by persons resident therein, and for the distribution of funds provided by the said Act for immigration purposes, and for the introduction into and settlement in such Province of Immigrants, and for selling as special settlements for any such Immigrants any lands which he may acquire from any Province under the provisions therein contained, or any lands acquired under "The New Zealand Settlements Act, 1863," or the Acts amending the same, and for laying out and allotting any lands so acquired amongst any such Immigrants: And whereas by "The Immigration and Public Works Act Amendment Act, 1871," it is among other things enacted that so much of the thirty-ninth and forty-first sections of the said Act as provide that any acts, matters, or things are to or may be done by the Governor at the request of the Superintendent of a Province, is thereby repealed; and it is thereby enacted that the Governor may exercise all the powers, and do and perform all the acts, matters, and things in the said sections mentioned, without any request from any Superintendent of any Province or any other person in authority:

And whereas, in pursuance of the power and authority contained in the said first-mentioned Act, the Governor, at the request of certain Superintendents of Provinces, did make certain Regulations for the intro-

duction of Immigrants from Europe into those Provinces respectively, on the nomination of persons resident therein: And whereas it hath been determined to make other Regulations in lieu of those so made as aforesaid:

Now therefore, I, Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the hereinbefore in part-recited Acts, and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, do hereby make the regulations set forth in the Schedule hereto for the introduction of Immigrants from Europe into the Colony of New Zealand, on the nomination of persons resident therein.

#### SCHEDULE.

#### REGULATIONS FOR THE INTRODUCTION OF IMMIGRANTS INTO NEW ZEALAND, ON THE NOMINATION OF PERSONS RESIDENT THEREIN.

1. The Immigration Regulations and Forms of Application may be obtained at any Post Office or Immigration Office in the Colony; but applications and payments for passages are only to be made to *Money Order* Post Offices, or to the Immigration Officer at the capital town of each Province or County.

2. Any person resident in the Colony, desirous of nominating relatives or friends in Europe for passages to New Zealand, may do so by paying at any *Money Order* Post Office or to the Immigration Officers aforesaid the sum of £5 for each adult (except single women) under 50 years of age, and £2 10s. for each child under 12 years of age. Infants under one year, free. In certain cases, bills will be taken in lieu of cash payments, and passages will be provided for persons over fifty years of age. (See clause 6, sections 1 and 3.)

Widows with families are, as a rule, not eligible, and applications for passages in their behalf are only to be made to the Immigration Officers aforesaid. (See clause 6, sec. 4.)

3. Free passages will be granted to girls of 12 years of age and upwards accompanying their parents, and to single women between the ages of 16 and 35 provided they are able to produce proof of good character to the satisfaction of the Agent General in London.

4. Every single woman will be required, before embarkation, to pay to the Agent-General 25s., and every other adult 20s. (and children in proportion), for bedding, blankets, and mess utensils.

5. In the event of any emigrant applied for declining to emigrate, whatever money or bills may have been deposited with the Government will be returned to the applicant so soon as the Agent-General shall have apprised the Government thereof; but in the event of any emigrant applied for accepting the offer of a passage in a particular ship, and so, by failing to present himself for embarkation at the time and port appointed by the Agent-General for the sailing of such ship, be left behind, the passage money will be forfeited.

6. The Immigration Officer at the capital town in each Province or County (and he only) will receive applications as under:—

1. From persons who may wish to give bills for the passage money of their relatives or friends, instead of paying cash, as provided for in clause 1. The amount of the bills to be taken will be 50 per cent. over the amount above fixed to be paid in cash, and the bills will become due 30 days after the arrival of the immigrants sent for.
2. From persons who desire to leave to their agents in Europe the nomination of emigrants of any particular class. The terms will be the same as if nominated in the Colony.

3. From persons whose friends are over 50 years of age.

4. From persons whose friends are widows with children.

7. The above rates being only for the passage from the port of embarkation to the Colony, the cost of conveyance to such port and to the residence of their friends after arrival in the Colony, must be defrayed by the emigrants themselves.

8. All the ships employed in this service will be under the provisions of the Passenger Act.

9. It is to be distinctly understood that, notwithstanding applications may have been granted at the Money Order Post Offices, the Immigration Officers aforesaid are empowered to object to any of the emigrants so nominated being sent out, either from unsuitability of occupation or from any other cause; and the Agent-General in London will have power to refuse passages where the intending emigrants are in ill-health, or in any way unfitted, according to his judgment, to undertake the voyage.

Given under the hand of His Excellency Sir George Ferguson Bowen, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, at the Government House, at Wellington, this first day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two.
