By JAMES A. R. MENZIES, Esquire,  
Superintendent of the Province of  
Southland.

**I**N pursuance of the power in me vested,  
I do hereby proclaim and declare that  
the Districts described in the Schedule  
following shall be Districts for the pur-  
pose of Slaughtering Cattle under the  
provisions of the "Slaughter House Or-  
dinance, 1847;" and I further declare  
that the provisions of the said Ordinance  
shall come into operation within the said  
Districts on the fifteenth day of Septem-  
ber, 1863.

One thousand eight hundred  
and sixty-three.

WINTON DISTRICT.

Bounded on the south and south-east by  
the Dacre District (as proclaimed in

the "Southland Gazette," No. 48,  
4th July, 1863); on the west by the  
Oreti River; on the north and north-  
east by a right line drawn from Ship  
Cone (Ohukama) towards Dipton  
Bush, to its intersection of the  
Oreti.

LOWTHER DISTRICT.
