PROCLAMATION.

By WILLIAM HUGH NURSE, Esquire,
Deputy Superintendent of the
Province of Southland, in the
Colony of New Zealand.

IN pursuance of the powers vested in me in that behalf by the Hospitals Ordinance, 1863, I hereby proclaim and declare that the provisions of the said Hospitals Ordinance, 1863, shall from and after the publication hereof, be applied to the Institution known as the Invercargill Hospital, for the purposes of which the building and parcel of land described in the Schedule hereunder written, have heretofore been used.

SCHEDULE.

Hospital Reserve.

All that piece or parcel of land, situated on the North West corner of the Town of Invercargill, and bounded on the east by Dee-street—a distance of two hundred and eighty-four (284)

links; on the north by a street, being the north boundary of the aforesaid Town of Invercargill; towards the west by the Oreti Railway Reserve—a distance of three hundred and eighty-six (386) links; on the south by a reserve for Public Gardens—a distance of five hundred and seventy-nine (579) links; again on the east by Leven-street—a distance of one hundred (100) links; again on the south by Gala-street—a distance of six hundred (600) links, and containing by admeasurement three (3) acres two (2) roods and thirty-eight (38) poles be the same, more or less.

PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by a proclamation issued under the hand of J. A. R. Menzies, Esq., Superintendent of the Province of Southland, and dated the 9th day of July, 1863, the boundaries of the Aparima School District were set forth and declared; and whereas it is expedient to abolish the same, and appoint other boundaries for the said School District: Now, therefore, I, the said Deputy Superintendent, in pursuance of the power vested in me in that behalf, and in conformity with the provisions of Section 6, of the "Education Ordinance, No. 2, 1862," do hereby abolish the boundaries of the said Aparima School District, as the same were defined in the schedule to the Proclamation aforesaid, and declare that the boundaries of the said District shall be the boundaries set forth in the Schedule hereinafter written.

Bounded on the east, by the Aparima River; on the south, by the Aparima River, and the estuary of the same; on the west by the Pura Pura Kina, and west boundary of Block XIII, Jacob's River Hundred; on the north and north-east, by the north boundary of the said Block XIII, by the west boundary and the north boundary of Block VIII of the said Hundred.

In the matter of SYDNEY THOMAS BULL and FREDERICK DALE, both of Invercargill, in the Province of Southland, and Colony of New Zealand, Merchants, carrying on business in Invercargill aforesaid, as Storekeepers and Merchants, under the style or firm of BULL & DALE, and in the matter of the petition of JOHN MACPHERSON, of Invercargill aforesaid, Merchant, sole partner of the firm of MACPHERSON & COMPANY, creditor of the said SYDNEY THOMAS BULL, and the said firm of BULL & DALE, to the extent of not less than fifty pounds, and in the matter of "The Debtors and Creditors Act, 1862."

The third day of July, in the year of our Lord, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-five.

UPON reading the abovementioned petition, and the minutes of meeting of creditors filed herein, and the two affidavits of the above-named John Macpherson, severally sworn and filed herein, and upon hearing Mr Kenyon of counsel, for the said John Macpherson, it is ordered that Robert Chapman, Esq., Registrar at Dunedin, in the Province of Otago, of this honorable Court, do, in the name and on behalf of Sydney Thomas Bull, and Frederick Dale abovenamed, cede and deliver, convey and assign to the abovenamed John Macpherson and Robert Buchanan of Invercargill, aforesaid, merchant, their heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns respectively,

according to the nature and quality thereof respectively, all the joint estate and effects of them, the said Sydney Thomas Bull and Frederick Dale, upon trust, for the purpose of selling, disposing of, getting in and receiving, or otherwise realizing the same, and in the first place, of satisfying thereout all costs, charges, and expenses incurred by order of this Court, or incidental to the execution of the trust of such conveyance and assignment and all fees of Court, and all payments to the insolvent estate fund, payable under Section thirty-nine of the said Act. And such other sums (if any), as shall be ordered by this Court, and for the payment of all costs and expenses properly incurred up to this date by the abovenamed John Macpherson, as sequestrator of the estate and effects of the said insolvents, in and about these matters, upon the same first being taxed by the Registrar at Invercargill of this

honorable Court, and subject thereto; and for the purpose of justly distributing and administering the clear residue of the said monies between and amongst, and for the benefit of all the joint creditors of the said Sydney Thomas Bull and Frederick Dale, at the time of the presentation of the said petition, and who shall duly prove their respective debts by affidavit, filed in the office of the said Registrar at Invercargill, within six calendar months from this date by way of pro rata distribution, and subject to existing legal priorities, and upon, and subject to such further trusts and provisions, as this Court at or before the final hearing of this order, direct or approve.
