PROCLAMATION

By the Honorable JOHN PARKIN TAYLOR,
Esquire, Superintendent of the
Province of Southland.

WHEREAS by Proclamation dated the tenth day of February, one Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Five, the Provincial Council of the Province of Southland was summoned to meet for the despatch of business on Tuesday, the sixth day of March instant:

And whereas it is expedient to Prorogue the same, now therefore I, JOHN PARKIN TAYLOR Superintendent of the Province of Southland, do hereby Prorogue the said Provincial Council to Thursday, the eighth day of March instant; and I do
