A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by an Order in Council made on the twenty-fifth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, the Province of Southland was constituted and established under "The New Provinces Act, 1858," and it is provided by the Constitution Act, that it shall be lawful for the Governor of New Zealand, by proclamation or otherwise, to dissolve the Provincial Council of any Province, whenever he shall think it expedient so to do:

Now, therefore, I, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, in exercise of the said power, do, by this proclamation, dissolve the Provincial Council of the said Province of Southland.
