PROCLAMATION

By the Honorable JOHN PARKIN TAYLOR, Esq., Superintendent  
of the Province of Southland.

**I**N pursuance and exercise of the power in me vested in this behalf I do hereby constitute and appoint to be a Gold Field under the provisions of the "Gold Fields Act, 1866," all that portion of Stewart's Island north of latitude 46.50, under the name of the Stewart's Island Gold Fields.

of August, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-  
nine.
