PROCLAMATION.

By the Honorable JOHN PARKIN TAYLOR,
Superintendent of the Province of
Southland.

WHEREAS by an act of the General Assembly of New Zealand the short title whereof is "The Superintendent's Deputy Act, 1866," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Superintendent of any province by proclamation to be published in the 'Government Gazette' of such province to appoint such person as he may think fit, being an inhabitant of such province, and being registered as an elector on the electoral roll of some electoral district within such province to be his Deputy, and as such to do perform and exercise all the acts, powers, and authorities (except as in the seventh clause of the said act is excepted) which may be done, performed, or exercised by such Superintendent, and that it shall be lawful for any Superintendent at any time and from time to time by proclamation published in the 'Government Gazette' of the province to remove any person appointed by him or by his predecessor in office to be Deputy-Superintendent of his province, and whereas on the the twenty-third day of July, one thousand eight hundred and sixty eight, in pursuance and in exercise

of the power and authority vested in me in this behalf, I did, by proclamation published in the Southland Provincial 'Government Gazette,' appoint

HENRY ARMSTRONG, Esq.,

being an inhabitant of the said province, registered as an elector on the electoral roll of the New River District, within the province of Southland aforesaid, to be my Deputy, and as such to perform and exercise all the acts, powers, and authorities (except as in the seventh clause of "The Superintendent's Deputy Act, 1866," is excepted), and whereas the said Henry Armstrong is now absent from the colony without having formally resigned the office of Deputy-Superintendent as aforesaid, and whereas it is expedient to remove Henry Armstrong from the office of Deputy-Superintendent of the province of Southland. Now, therefore, in pursuance of the power in me vested in that behalf, I do hereby remove the said Henry Armstrong from the office of Deputy-Superintendent of the province of Southland.
