PROCLAMATION

By his Honor JOHN PERRY ROBINSON, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, in the Islands of New Zealand, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the power in me vested, I do hereby proclaim and declare that from and after the day of the date hereof the Province of TARANAKI, in the Colony of New Zealand, shall be deemed to be an *Infected District* within the meaning of the "Diseased Cattle Act, 1861," and that no Cattle shall be allowed to be imported from that District into the Province of Nelson.

Given under my hand and issued under the Public Seal of this Province, this twelfth day of January, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-five.
