## PROCLAMATION

By his Honor HENRY ROBERT RICHMOND, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki.

**W**HEREAS Edward Smyth Willcocks, Esquire, Returning Officer for the Province of Taranaki, did, on the 7th September instant, openly declare and publicly notify that at the election of a Superintendent for the Province of Taranaki, I, HENRY ROBERT RICHMOND, was duly elected by a majority of the voters of the whole Province to be Superintendent thereof. Now, therefore, I do hereby proclaim and declare that I have assumed the office of Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki accordingly, and I hereby call upon the inhabitants of the said Province to aid and assist me therein.

## PROCLAMATION

By his Honor HENRY ROBERT RICHMOND, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki.

**W**HEREAS by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled

the "Superintendents Deputy Act, 1856," it is amongst other things enacted that it shall be lawful for the Superintendent of any Province, by proclamation to be published in the *Government Gazette* of such Province, to appoint such person as he may think fit, being a registered elector of such Province, to be his Deputy, and as such to perform and exercise all the acts and powers (except such powers as are conferred by the Constitution Act, 15 and 16 Vic., c. 72), which may be exercised and performed by such Superintendent, or such of them only as shall be specified in such proclamation. Now, therefore, I, the Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki, do hereby appoint

WILLIAM NORTHCOFT

to be my Deputy during my absence from the said Province, and as such to perform and exercise all the acts and powers appertaining to the office of Superintendent except such as are conferred by the Constitution Act.
