IN exercise of the authority vested in the Superintendent by an Ordinance of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of Taranaki, intituled "The Branding of Cattle Ordinance, 1865," I, HENRY ROBERT RICHMOND, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki, do hereby revoke the notice constituting districts under the said Ordinance, dated 31st August, 1865, and published in the Provincial *Gazette* No. 22, 4th September, 1865, in so far as it relates to the district therein described as No. 2 District, and I hereby constitute the following districts in lieu thereof, for the purposes of the said Ordinance:

No. 2 DISTRICT;

The Block of Land bounded towards the West by the Henui River, and towards the East by the Mangorei River to its junction with the Waiwakaiho River, and thence to the sea by the Waiwakaiho River, and consisting of part of No. 3 and the whole of Nos. 2 and 10 Road Districts.

No. 6 DISTRICT;

The Block of Land lying between the Mangorei and Waiwakaiho Rivers, and consisting of part of No. 3 Road District.

THE following descriptions of the Road Districts, under the "Roads and Bridges Ordinance, 1858," are reprinted for general information from the *Gazettes* of the 23rd May, 1857, and the 8th May, 1858.

H. R. RICHMOND,
Superintendent.

1st District.—All Lands East of the Waiwakaio as far as the Mangoraka.

2nd District.—All Lands bounded as follows, viz. :—On the North by the sea, on the East by the River Waiwakaio, on the South by the southern boundary of the Native Reserve No. 3, and by the northern boundary of so much of the Avenue Road as is within the said Reserve, on the West by the western boundary of the said Reserve to its junction with the River Henui at the northwest corner of the said Reserve; thence by the said river to the sea.

3rd District.—All Lands bounded as follows, viz. :—On the North by the Town, on the East by the River Henui to its junction with the north-west corner of the Native Reserve No. 3; thence by the western boundary of the said Reserve to the Avenue Road; thence by the north side of the said road to the southern boundary of the said Reserve; thence by the said boundary to the River Waiwakaio; thence by the said river to its junction with the boundary of the Omata Block; thence by the said boundary to the River Mangorei; thence by the said river to the western boundary of land belonging to H. Turner; thence by the said boundary to the Mangorei road; thence by the north-west side of the said road to the eastern boundary of land belonging to J. Collins; thence by the said boundary to the River Henui; thence by the said river to the boundary line between sections 75 and 76; thence by the said boundary and by the boundary between sections 62 and 63, 48 and 49, 34 and 35, and by a line produced through the belt land D to the boundary of the Town.

4th District.—All Lands bounded as follows, viz. :—On the North by the Town, on the East by the Third District to the River Henui; thence along the said river to the boundary

of the Omata Block; thence along the said boundary to the Hurford Road; thence along the east side of the said road to the boundary line between sections 100 and 107, 129, 113; thence by the said boundary to the Frankley Road; thence by the east side of the Frankley Road to the boundary line between sections 90 and 93; thence by the said boundary to the Carrington Road; thence by the west side of the Carrington Road to the boundary line between sections 90 and 96; thence by the said boundary to the Huatoki stream; thence by the Huatoki stream to the boundary of the Town.

5th District.—All Lands bounded as follows, viz. :—On the North by the Town, on the East by the Fourth District, and on the West by the East side of the Hurford Road to the boundary line between sections 120 and 100; thence by the said boundary and by the boundary lines between sections 99 and 120, 95A, 95, 94 and 105, 104, 94, and 91, to the Ngakara stream; thence by the Ngakara to the boundary line between sections 86 and 89; thence by the said boundary to the boundary line between sections 81 and 89; thence by the said boundary to the Barrett Road; thence by the east side of the Barrett Road to the boundary line between sections 76 and 54; thence by the said boundary to the Paritutu line; thence by the Paritutu line to the boundary line between sections 501 and 489A; and thence by the said boundary and the boundaries between sections 502 and 490, 490 and 491, 491 and 479, 479 and 480, 480 and 67, 67 and 68, 54 and 55, 55 and 41, 41 and 42, 42 and 28, 43 and 29, 29 and 30, 30 and 21, 21 and 22, to the Town boundary.

6th District.—All Lands bounded as follows, viz. :—On the North by the Sea, on the East by the west side of the Cutfield Road and Town boundary to the boundary of the Fifth District; thence by the said boundary to the Ngakara stream; and on the West by the Ngakara to a line drawn through section No. 65 to the boundary line between sections 64 and 77; thence by the said boundary to the Phenev Road; thence by the north side of the said road to the boundary line between

sections 60 and 75; thence by the said boundary and by a line running through section 47 until it meets the Mango-hererangistream; thence by the said stream to the Herekawe to the boundary line between sections 3 and 4; thence by a line through sections 3 and 13 crossing the junction of the Barrett and Omata Roads to the junction of sections 5, 6, 13, and 14; thence by the boundary line between sections 14 and 6 to the boundary line between section No. 6 and the Native Reserve No. 1; thence by the said boundary to the Devon Road; thence by the said road to a road between the Native Reserve No. 1 and the Mission Station; thence by the said road to the beach.

7th District.—All Lands bounded as follows, viz. :—On the North by the Tapuae and Ngakara streams; thence on the East by the boundaries of the Fifth and Fourth Districts, and on the West by the boundary line of the Omata block.

8th District.—All Lands West of the boundary of the Omata Block.

9th District.—All Lands bounded as follows, viz. :—On the North by the Sea, on the East by the Sixth District, on the South by the Seventh District, and on the West by the boundary of the Omata block.

10th District.—All lands bounded as follows, viz. :—Towards the North by the Third District; towards the East by the River Mangorei; towards the South by the boundary of the Omata block; and towards the West by the River Henui.

COMMISSION.

International and Industrial Exhibitions to be held in Bombay, Paris, and Melbourne, respectively.

By his Excellency Sir GEORGE GREY, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

TO THEIR HONORS THE SUPERINTENDENTS FOR THE TIME BEING OF THE PROVINCES IN THE COLONY OF NEW ZEALAND, GREETING,—

WHEREAS it has been proposed that an International Exhibition of Works of Industry and Art should be held in

Bombay, which Exhibition it is proposed should be opened on the fourth day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six.

And whereas it has been proposed that a similar Exhibition should be held in Paris in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven.

And whereas it has been proposed that a similar Exhibition should be held in Melbourne in the early part of the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six.

And whereas it is expedient that a Commission should be appointed for the purpose of securing the proper representation, at such aforesaid Exhibitions respectively, of the produce, arts, and manufactures of the colony of New Zealand.

Now know ye, that I, the Governor, reposing great trust and confidence in your knowledge and ability, have authorised and appointed you, and do by these presents authorise and appoint you, the said Superintendents for the time being of the provinces in the Colony of New Zealand, to be a Commission for the purpose of securing the proper representation at such aforesaid Exhibitions respectively, of the produce, arts, and manufactures of the said Colony.

And I do hereby further authorize you respectively to appoint in the several Provinces of which you are Superintendents, local Committees of such persons as each of you may consider it expedient to appoint for the purpose of encouraging the production of articles to be exhibited.

And I do hereby further authorise you respectively to conduct communication between the Exhibitors and the Commissioners of the several aforesaid proposed Exhibitions.

And I do hereby give and grant you the said Commission, and each of you power and authority by all lawful means and ways whatsoever, to carry out all matters and things tending to the completion of the object of this Commission.

Given under my hand, at the Government House, at Wellington, and issued under the Seal of the Colony of New Zealand, this thirteenth day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five.
