### NOTICE

*Constituting No. 18 District under the  
"Roads and Bridges Ordinance, 1858."*

Superintendent's Office,  
New Plymouth, Jan. 5, 1867.

**WHEREAS** by the 2nd clause of the "Roads and Bridges Ordinance, 1858," it is provided that it shall be lawful for the Superintendent, amongst other things, to constitute Districts within which the provisions of the said Ordinance shall be in force. Provided that no such notice shall at any time be published without the previous approval of the Provincial Council. Now therefore I, HENRY ROBERT RICHMOND, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki, in exercise of the before recited authority, do hereby, with the approval of the Provincial Council, constitute the undermentioned block of land, known as the Clifton District, to be District No. 18, under the provisions of the said recited Ordinance.

DISTRICT No. 18.

The block of land bounded towards the north-east and north by the sea coast, towards the south-east by the Warau stream, and a line from the western corner

of rural allotment No. 1 to the southern corner of rural allotment No. 33, and towards the west by Mimi stream.

*Appointing a Rate for No. 18 Road District.*

And whereas by the 49th clause of the said Ordinance, power is given to the Superintendent, with the approval of the Provincial Council, by notice to be published in the *Government Gazette*, to alter the minimum rate or rates to be imposed in one or more districts. Now therefore I, HENRY ROBERT RICHMOND, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki, do hereby, with the approval of the Provincial Council, alter the minimum rate of Sixpence to Threepence for the undermentioned District:—
