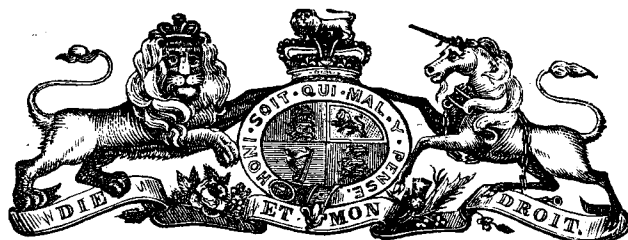

VACCINATION NOTICE.

Superintendent's Office,
New Plymouth, February 6, 1869.

IT is hereby notified for general information that the Vaccination Officers appointed under the "Vaccination Act, 1863," will attend for the purpose of Vaccinating, and also of inspecting the progress of Vaccination previously performed, at the following places and hours:—

Dr. Rawson—At his residence in Fulford-street, (near the Freemasons' Hall), every day, from 2 to 3 p.m.

Mr. O'Carroll, Surgeon—At his residence in Devon-street, every Friday, at any hour of the day.

Mr. Humphries, Surgeon—At Messrs. Humphries' Store, Devon-street, every Saturday, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Mr. St. George, Surgeon—At Mr. A. Rawson's, Druggist, Currie-street, every Saturday, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

N.B.—All children of the Native race and the children of Europeans, who are unable to pay, can be Vaccinated free of charge at the Provincial Hospital, any Saturday between the hours of 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.

As the disease of small pox is now prevalent in some of the Australian Colonies and cases have occurred in New Zealand,

the attention of parents and guardians is especially called to the importance of causing all children to be Vaccinated without delay who have not already been Vaccinated successfully. Attention is also called to the 10th and 11th clauses of the "Vaccination Act, 1863," by which penalties are imposed for the neglect of Vaccination, and for neglecting to bring children who have been Vaccinated to be inspected by the Medical Officer by whom it was performed, on the eighth day after Vaccination.

NEW RIFLE RANGE, HENUI BEACH.

PUBLIC NOTICE.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Beach between the Henui and Waiwakaiho Rivers is constituted a RIFLE RANGE for Rifle practice, and will be open for that purpose under such regulations as may be deemed necessary by the Officer Commanding the Militia and Volunteers.

A Red Flag will be fixed on an elevated position in the vicinity of the Target, near the Henui, on the north side, when practice is going on; and at such times it will be unsafe to pass along the Beach from the Waiwakaiho to the Henui.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by the second section of "The Colonial Forces Courts-Martial Act, 1868," it is enacted that the Governor may from time to time, by Proclamation published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, appoint and declare any portion of the Colony defined in such Proclamation to be a "Disturbed District" within the meaning of the said second section of the said Act; and that during the time that any of the officers or men of the New Zealand Armed Constabulary, embodied under "The Armed Constabulary Act, 1867," shall be stationed, employed, or in any way on service within any district proclaimed under the said section of the said Act as a Disturbed District, all things contained in any Act of the Imperial Parliament which shall then be in force in New Zealand for punishing Mutiny and Desertion, and for the better payment of the Army and their quarters, and in the Articles of War made in pursuance of such Act shall apply to, and the powers thereby created shall be exercised by, such officers and men of the New Zealand Armed Constabulary aforesaid:

Now therefore I, Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of New Zealand, in exercise and in pursuance of the power and authority in that behalf vested in me, do hereby proclaim and declare all that portion of the Colony situated within the Province of Taranaki and bounded as follows, that is to say:—On the South by River Hangatahua from its mouth to its source, thence a straight line to the summit of Mount Egmont, thence by a straight line running due East to the eastern boundary of the said Province; on the East by the eastern boundary of the said Province; on the North by the northern boundary of the said Province; on the West by the sea,—to be a "Disturbed District" within the meaning of the second section of "The Colonial Forces Courts-Martial Act, 1868," aforesaid.

Given under the hand of His Excellency Sir George Ferguson Bowen, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, at the Government House, at Wellington; and issued under the Seal of the said Colony, this tenth day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, at Wellington, this twenty-sixth day of February, 1869.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by "The Militia Act, 1865," it is provided that the Governor in Council may from time to time constitute districts throughout the Colony, or in any part thereof, and may designate the Militia of any such district by such name as he may think fit:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise and pursuance of the power and authority conferred on him by the said Act, and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Colony, doth hereby constitute all that part of the Colony situated in the Province of Taranaki, whereof the boundaries are as follows:—On the South by the River Hangatahua from its mouth to its source, thence a straight line to the summit of Mount Egmont, thence by a straight line running due East to the eastern boundary of the said Province; on the East by the eastern boundary of the said Province; on the North by the northern boundary of the said Province; on the West by the sea—to be a District within the meaning and for the purposes of the said Act, and doth designate the Militia of the said District as "The Taranaki Militia."
