ELECTORAL NOTICE.

## ROADS AND BRIDGES.

*Notice fixing the Minimum Rates, and appointing General Meetings of the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th, 17th, 18th, 19th, 20th, 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 25th, and 26th Districts.*

WHEREAS by the 49th Clause of the "Roads and Bridges Ordinance, 1858," power is given to the Superintendent, with the approval of the Provincial Council, by notice to be published in the *Government Gazette*, to alter the minimum Rates to be imposed in any District. Now therefore I, FREDERIC ALONZO CARRINGTON, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Taranaki, do hereby, with the approval of the Provincial Council, appoint that the minimum Rate to be imposed in all the Districts hitherto constituted under the above recited Ordinance shall be Threepence per acre for the ensuing year, from the 1st July, 1874, to the 30th June, 1875, excepting in Districts 18, 24, 25, and 26, in which the minimum Rate shall be Twopence per acre for the same period. And I hereby further appoint that General Meetings of Ratepayers in the said Districts shall be
