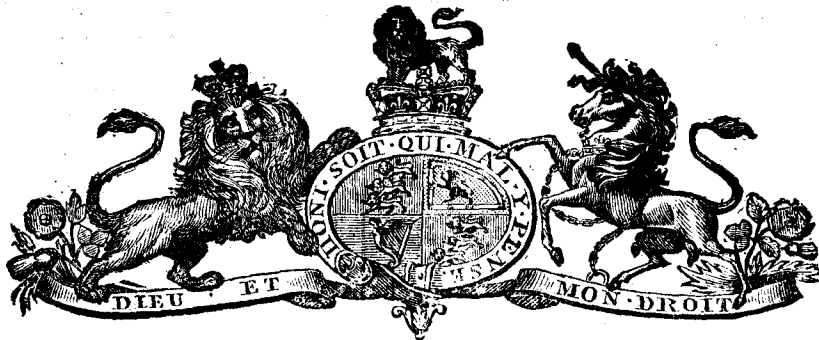

WE, the undersigned, having at the request of your Honor, investigated the supplementary claims of persons applying as being entitled to receive scrip under the "Volunteer Land Act, 1865," have the honor to submit the following as our Report:—

The total number of supplementary claims was eighty-one, and of these we have allowed the claims of sixty-nine, and felt ourselves compelled to reject those of the remaining twelve.

The total gross value of the scrip awarded to the sixty-nine applicants whose claims have been allowed, amounts to £970, of which £180 is for Volunteer service, and £790 for active service in the field.

Of the sixty-nine successful claimants, nine have previously had scrip awarded, and are appellants against the decision of the former Committee as to the amount to which they are entitled. The remainder have now advanced their claims for the first time.

**CROWN GRANTS.**

Crown Lands Office,  
 New Plymouth, 9th Dec., 1874.

**T**HE Deeds of Grant below specified having been duly executed, are now ready for registration and delivery, on the following conditions:—

The Grantee, or his properly authorised representative, must, in the first place, make application to the Commissioner of Crown Lands for the delivery of the Grant, and pay the fee of One Pound for the Crown Grants, together with acreage at the rate of one farthing per acre on every acre granted beyond 100 acres, and registration fees.

The Grant will then be forwarded to the Registrar of Deeds, and the applicant will be furnished with a written authority to receive it from that officer after Registration.

**N.B.**—A fee of sixpence per month will be charged on all Grants remaining in the Crown Lands Office after three months from date of publication in the Provincial Government Gazette.

To the District Officer, Commissioner of Crown Lands, Inspector of Surveys, and Native Reserves Commissioner, and to all others whom it may concern:

NOTICE is hereby given, that the persons named in the first column of the Schedule hereeto, on behalf of themselves or the hapus mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule, have duly given notice that they claim to be interested in the pieces of land named and described in the third column of the said Schedule respectively; and that they desire that their respective claims should be investigated by the Native Land Court, in order that Memorials of Ownership may be issued for the same. And the said claimants admits the persons or hapus mentioned in the fourth column of the said Schedule to be also interested in the said land.
