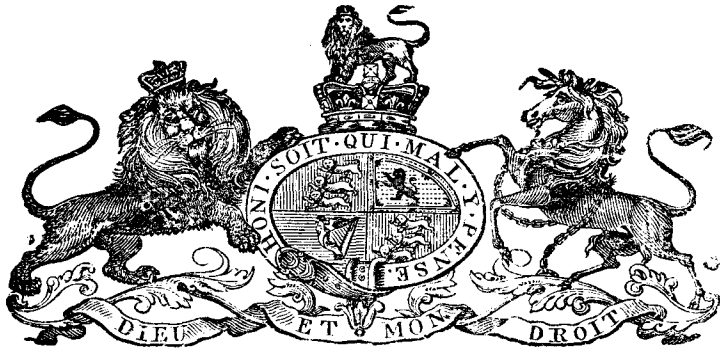

CROWN GRANTS.

Crown Lands Office,  
New Plymouth, February 1, 1876.  
**T**HE DEEDS of GRANT below  
specified having been duly  
executed, are now ready for  
REGISTRATION and delivery, on  
the following conditions:—  
The Grantee or his properly  
authorised representative must, in the  
first place, make application to the  
Commissioner of Crown Lands for the  
delivery of the Grant, and pay the fee  
of One Pound for the Crown Grant,  
together with acreage at the rate of  
One Farthing per acre on every acre

granted beyond one hundred (100)  
acres, and registration fees.

The Grant will then be forwarded to  
the Registrar of Deeds, and the  
applicant will be furnished with a  
written authority to receive it from that  
office after registration.

N.B.—A fee of Sixpence per month  
will be charged on all grants remaining  
in the Crown Lands Office after three  
months from date of publication in the  
Provincial Government Gazette.

**CROWN GRANTS.**

Crown Lands Office,  
New Plymouth, February 23, 1876.

**T**HE Deeds of Grant below specified having been duly executed, are now ready for registration and delivery, on the following conditions:—

The Grantee, or his properly authorised representative, must, in the first place, make application to the Commissioner of Crown Lands for the delivery of the Grant, and pay the fee of one pound for the Crown Grant, together with the acreage at the rate of one farthing per acre on every acre granted beyond 100 acres, and registration fees.

The Grant will then be forwarded to the Registrar of Deeds, and the applicant will be furnished with a written authority to receive it from that officer after registration.

N.B.—A fee of sixpence per month will be charged on all Grants remaining in the Crown Lands Office after three months from date of publication in the Provincial *Government Gazette*.
