

corner of Allotment number 1791, 1640 links; thence by a line bearing 145° magnetic, 550 links, and another line at a right angle in a south-westerly direction, 9 links; thence by a line bearing 145° , 795 links, and another line bearing 55° , 40 links; thence to the north-east corner of Allotment number 1927, 266 links; thence by a continuation of the north side of Shortland Street, 133 links; thence to the south-east corner of Allotment number 1947, 345 links; thence in a straight line to the north-west corner of Allotment number 1252, 1054 links; thence along the east boundary of Reserve C and W to Allotment number 1123, 2004 links; thence by a line bearing 235° magnetic, 860 links, to the Hinakahi Stream; thence by the said stream to the south side of Wallace Place; thence by the south side of Wallace Place, bearing 235° magnetic, to the west side of Outfield Road, 3560 links; and thence in a straight line bearing 325° , forming the west side of Outfield Road, to the point first mentioned, 6413 links; which said boundaries are more particularly delineated by a pink line on the plan herewith annexed, being a copy of the official plan of the Town of New Plymouth deposited in the Provincial Survey Office, New Plymouth.
